写在前面

本词典共选编了 1000 余组英语同义词和近义词，涉及词汇约 5700 个。所选词汇主要以教育部对高等学校非英语专业本科生的推荐词汇量为基准，即 4795 个单词和 700 个词组（含中学应掌握的词汇），同时参照《大学英语课程教学要求》中所附的《大学英语参考词汇表》，对其收录的 7676 个单词尽量予以吸收，基本上涵盖了英语学习中经常遇到的同义词和近义词问题。主要适用对象为中学、大学师生及参加各类英语考试的人员。

美国著名作家马克·吐温曾说过：“用词准确与用词几乎准确，这两者之间的差异就如闪电与萤火虫之间的差异。”(The difference between the right word and the almost-right word is as great as that between lightning and the lightning bug.) 由此可见用词精当的重要性，这其中同样包括对同义词、近义词的选择。

语言习得是一个漫长而渐进的过程。对中国学生而言，母语是汉语，英语为第二语言。学习英语主要依赖课本及课堂，课时较少，语言环境不甚理想，尤其缺乏课后的语言实践，因而难以达到熟练自如的程度。鉴于此，笔者依据自己几十年所积累的英语教学经验及教学资料，结合国内外相关的学术著作及朗文、牛津、剑桥、韦氏等权威词典，选编出大量实用的同义词词组，同时还在例证中增加了许多比较实用的新词和当今流行的词语，力图以自己的绵薄之力，助力莘莘学子及英语爱好者。

本词典在编排上尝试了一些创新之举，旨在尽量方便读者查阅和使用。如给各组同义词设立了【导航词义】标签，使所涉词义凸显，读者在快速浏览之际，即可确定是否为所要查阅的内容；在各条目词之下，均设有【辨析】、【例证】等标签，使相关部分的内容异常醒目，一目了然；在一些条目词下，还专门增设了【小贴士】，目的是对该词容易出错之处给予提示，对近年来出现的新义、新用法等加以介绍，或补充联想词语，扩展相关内容。

本词典在编写过程中，注重突出以下特色：

◆ 收词全面。各组同义词均经过仔细的筛选组合，尽量避免遗漏。如在 seek, comb, hunt, search（导航词义：寻找）这组词中，专门增补了

comb一词，意为“对某处像梳头一般进行彻底搜寻”。除同义词外还收录同义短语，如bribe, corrupt, buy off（导航词义：行贿）。此外，还收录了一些多词条目，如a couple of, a pair of（导航词义：两个…，一对…），a great deal of, a lot of, plenty of（导航词义：许多…）。

◆ 辨析明了。对各组同义词都作了较详细的辨析，用清楚易懂的文字讲解各词的含义、特性、使用场合、搭配/连用词语等，力求要言不烦，言之有据。

◆ 提供新义。及时反映近年来出现的新义或新用法。如在thief, bandit, burglar, pickpocket, robber（导航词义：盗贼，强盗）这组词中，对其中的bandit一词既说明了指“结帮成伙、出没于乡间或山林地区使用恐吓或暴力手段抢劫的人”，又同时指出“现尤指袭击旅行者的歹徒”。

◆ 例证可靠。各条目词下一般均配有二至四条例证，包括搭配词语及例句。这些例证大多出自笔者自己的教学积累、已出版的各种论著、权威辞书等，并非凭空杜撰。

在本词典编写过程中，外语教学与研究出版社的申葳、王莹、杨镇明、詹莹玥诸位编辑给予了大力帮助。他们不仅悉心指导，而且还提供了许多宝贵的资料，借此机会特向他们表示衷心的感谢。

在此，我还要向那些在编写过程中给予帮助和支持的同事们、朋友们表示感谢。

因笔者水平有限，书中不免会出现这样或那样的不妥之处，诚望读者给予指正。
