## 前　　言

英语在其漫长的演变和发展过程中，吸收了大量外来语的词汇，尤其是拉丁语、希腊语和法语，衍生出无数的同义词，不仅成为世界上词汇量最丰富的语言之一，而且也成为世界上同义词最丰富多彩的语言之一。因此，学习英语同义词，辨别它们之间的细微差别，做到用词达意，准确表达思想，是掌握和应用英语的必经之路。记得有一位英国作家曾经说过：适当的地方用适当的词就是一篇好文章。这话里大概包含同义词的选择。所谓用词精当，撇开修辞因素，也同样包含同义词的选择。

有鉴于此，编者利用教学闲暇编写了这本词典，希望对广大英语学习者以及其他英语爱好者或从事英语教学工作者有一定的参考价值。

本词典共吸收 950 组英语同义词，涉及词汇 3 582 个，基本上涵盖了英语学习中经常遇到的同义词，其中绝大部分是常用的英语同义词。此外，本书还吸纳了一些不太常用的同义词，以满足不同读者的需要。

本书对所有的同义词都作了比较详细的辨析，并对几乎所有的同义词都提供了例句，而有些则以词组形式，既利于辨析，也为了减少篇幅。书末提供了索引，以便于读者查阅。

北京联合大学外语学院的冀玲惠老师也参与了本书部分内容的编写工作，参加本书编写的还有方亚男、左雪成、张雪良、陈文婷、许友、李薇、李永远等同志，在此表示感谢。

由于编者水平有限，书中如有错误或疏漏之处，祈请读者批评指正。
