本书根据最新考研英语考试大纲修订,主体部分词 汇约 5500 个。考生若掌握了这 5500 个精要词汇,就基 本突破了考研词汇难关。希望本书能帮助广大考生更 充分地备考。

根据多年的辅导经验,我们将主体部分每个字母组(如 A 开头的词汇为一组)的词汇,分两部分列出,突出特别需要考生记忆掌握的核心词汇,层次清晰明了:

所有的基础词汇(高中阶段词汇)汇总列在前面,建 议考生快速扫视,拎出个别陌生词后逐一突破;

考研核心词汇随后列出,并详解。几乎所有的核心词汇都通过完整的例句解释其用法(部分例句出自真题),这样考生就有一个很好的语境去完整准确地理解单词、记忆单词,并在加深词汇记忆的同时,增加实战体验。

理解和记忆词汇的最佳方式是借助语境学记,但最 根本的还在于持之以恒。本书条理明晰,排版醒目,小 而便携,内容含金量大,一反考研英语词汇书大部头的 传统,这样就方便了考生充分利用一切边角时间,重复 学习以达到熟能生巧,最终记住单词。

为了方便考生,本书后面另列了三项附录:考研必须掌握的词汇构词(前缀和后缀),并配例释;考研常用的词语搭配汇总;源于经验和对命题方向把握的一千多个超纲词汇(仅供考生参阅,不一定要背)。

无论什么方法,只要能记住单词,就是好方法。
