I. 快速阅读理解80题

本部分共分20个单元,每左、右各一页为一单元。在左页上有四个小故事(每篇70-80个词),在右页相应有四个选择问题,通过快速阅读,要求从中寻找出一个主题。每题约2.5分钟可以完成。因此,每一单元总共需10分钟。

阅读能力的培养应细水长流。上课前可以花1至10分钟作练习(少则2题,多则4题),估计20至40次即能完成全部阅读练习。这种化整为零的学习既不构成负担,又能有助于提高阅读的兴趣与能力。
