内 容 提 要

《Sharpen Your Ears》为清华大学外语系编写的《新英语教程》系列教科书的听力练习册。第一册含 16 个单元,每个单元分三大部分。第一部分为摘录自原声带的单句或短对话,第二部分为十个小对话,第三部分为两篇趣味小故事。练习形式多为多项性选择。该书第一版于 1989年出版,现为修订版,内容上作了较大更换和补充,四盒磁带全部重新录制。此书和《新英语教程》其它书在内容上无直接联系,故对不选学该教程的大学一年级学生或意欲提高自己听力的读者都适用。

前 言

《Sharpen Your Ears》为清华大学外语系编写的《新英语教程》系列教科书的听力练习册。全书分为两册,第一册适合大学一、二级学生使用,第二册适合大学三、四级学生使用。本书为第一册的修订版。

全书总的原则和安排不变,仍为 16 个单元,每单元分为三部分。

Part One: 含 10~15 个单句或 8 个对话,主要进行一些 微技能训练,有易混词辨别,缩略语、疑问词填写,数字听力训练等,练习形式为选择或填空。除 1~3 单元外全选摘自英美等国录制的原声带。修订版中我们调整了英音和美音的比例,换掉了一些语音不十分清晰或速度过快难于辨认的句子和对话。

Part Two: 每单元增为 10 个小对话,练习形式为多项性选择,每单元有一定的训练重点,最后两个单元为综合性练习。

Part Three: 仍为每单元含两篇趣味小故事,每篇故事后有5个问题,学生做多项性选择练习。我们调换了近一半的文章,以增加这部分的趣味性和训练的有效性。

本书配有四盒磁带,16个单元平均分布。第一部分主要摘自原声带,第二、三部分由外籍教师全部重新录制,录音清

晰,速度适中。为了增加带子容量,除部分单句外,对话和文章 都仅录了一遍。学生使用时如感到困难。可以播放两遍再做 练习。

本练习册属《新英语教程》的系列丛书,但它和该教程其它书无直接联系,故不选用《新英语教程》的学生也可用作课堂听力练习的补充或课外听力训练的材料。书中附有各单元答案和全部录音的文字材料。使用时请一定先听录音,做练习、对答案,发现错误再听录音以求理解,实在不明白时再看文字材料。

本书第一版发行五年来,很多老师和同学对此书给予了充分的肯定,也向我们提出了许多有益的建议,根据这些建议,我们对此书作了较大的修改,竭力使它更趋完善。但修改之处还需经过实践,才能证明其是否有效。我们恳请使用此书的老师和同学继续给我们以厚爱,对本书不足之处提出批评和指正。

本书由李相崇教授审阅, Mia Schleifer 女士和 Jonathan Young 先生录音, 我们向他们以及所有关心、支持、帮助过我们的同志们、朋友们表示深切的感谢。我们还从一些原声带中摘录了部分句子和对话, 在此不一一列举, 谨向原作者致以衷心的谢意。
