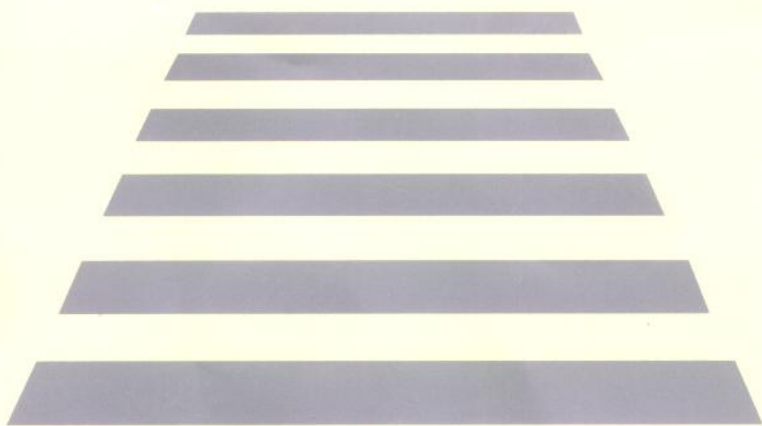

《英语听力基础强化》是根据“大学英语教学大纲”和四、六级考试大纲编写的教材。本教材重视英语听力基础,强调实用性,力求使学生在尽可能短的时间条件下在英语听力方面得到明显提高。
