TO THE READER

I personally prefer studying mathematics, physics and computer science to English. In order to get high scores in the GRE, I took the 1993 spring GRE class in Qian Jin College in Shanghai. The teachers were very good and helpful. On the first day of class, a professor said to us, "If you want to get a high score in the verbal part, you must be ready to write a dictionary." I was a little scared, but followed his directions. I think that this book will help you to write your own dictionary at least more easily, and hope that you can learn something from this book.

Holding a book does not mean you have knowledge. In order to get high scores in the GRE, hard work is definitely necessary. I believe that all the people who are preparing for the GRE have this in mind. As we know, remembering thousands of words doesn't mean that we know how to use it. The only way to use the words correctly and eloquently is to study them carefully.

The main characteristic of this book is that we study every word from many aspects which were picked up from actual GRE tests, GRE preparation books or other literature. We provide the words' etymology which helps us to understand their origins and the circumstances when to use them. We cluster synonyms and antonyms to help compare the slight differences among them. The unique feature of this book is the graph of words grouped together to show their connections. By using the graph, memorizing words becomes an easy task.

Moreover, most words in this book are advanced words in English. Grasping these elegant words can help you get high scores in the GRE. In order to use this book more efficiently, we strongly recommend using the words instead of only memorizing them. The examples given in this book will guide you in understanding the correct usage. All the definitions and examples in this book are selected from the famous books (the Bible, world-known novels, magazines and literature journals) and dictionaries (mainly from Barron's How to Prepare for the GRE, Webster Dictionary or Longman's Dictionary, etc). A large number of examples are directly excerpted from the Englsih novels in order to make you familiar with American culture.

My GRE score was 2,250 (Verbal 650, Mathematics 800, Analysis & Logic 800). After I took the test, some of my friends borrowed my notes for reference. All of them got scores of more than 2,000 and successfully obtained scholarships and assistantships offered by American universities. It was they who pushed me to publish it. However, it might be impossible to share my experience with you without the enthusiastic help of Professor Wang Shuquan, who grasps several foreign languages and is an expert in English, and stayed in the U.K. and Canada for years. At present, he is the English edi-

tor of the Journal of the Ocean University of Qindao, and spent incredible time in revising my notes. In a sense, he is the real author because I only found a fine stone, but he has sculptured it into a statue. It's my fortune to work with him.

Writing and publishing a book is always a tough job. It needs the cooperation among several people before it can appear in front of you. Here, Professor Wang and I cannot help appreciating the generous help and warm support from our friends and relatives. I'd like to thank Ms. Hsu-pieper, Mr. Lin Xijiang and Professor Shi Chuanjin for their great advice on the book.

编辑凡例

- 1. 本书将常见的 GRE 词汇根据词义之间的联系分成 779 组, 每组多者 20 几个词,少者仅一两个词。
- 2. 每词(词条词)依次给出①音标;②词性、词义(英、中文)、例句;③词源;④同义或近义词(Syn);⑤反义词(Ant);⑥其他有关的词(Reason)。在 Reason 中所列的一般都是词形相近,应特别注意区分的词;其词与词之间用线段甚至箭头连接,以帮助了解其关系。

但本书并不采取"一刀切"的办法,而是根据实际情况对每一词分别处理。例如,发音特别简单的,省去音标;词源不确定或帮助不大的,则不列词源,等等。

- 3. 正文中属于词条词者,一律以斜体印刷。书后附有按字母顺序排列的索引,给出每一个词条词的组号,以便查找。
- 4. 词源一项中许多是常见的,如 Gk,F,OE 等;少数较罕见的 意义为:LL(Late Latin ——约 2 世纪末至 6 世纪末的拉丁语),ON(Old Norse —— 14 世纪以前的挪威语)。
- 5. 书中符号所示:
 - ①M→N 表示按照从词 M 到词 N 的顺序记忆较好;
 - ②M↔N 表示词 M,N 在 GRE 中常被看作一对反义词;
 - ③M⇔N 表示对该组反义词应特别加以注意;
 - ④M>N 表示词 N 起源于词 M;M<N 则表示词 M 起源于

- ⑤M<=N表示 M起源于 N, 且 M 与 N 的某些词义相等;
- ⑥星号"*"表示应着重注意其后的释义或所列的词组。
- ⑦书"A:B::c:d"是GRE 中标准题型之一。符号"::"之前为两个大写词 A,B,其后为 4 组小写词 c,d,要求从中选出与 A,B 的相互关系最接近的一组词 c,d。
- 6. 书中酌情给出历年 GRE 的部分考题作为例子,例中出现的 词条词改为斜体,如 1995 年 GRE 中考到的单词,书中以 (GR95-4)的形式标出,供读者参考。

内容提要

本书在归纳 GRE 常考单词的基础上,根据 GRE 考试中词汇(VERBAL ABILITY)的考题类型对单词进行了全面的分析,提供了针对性极强的联想记忆方法,即对一个单词通过联想同义词、反义词、形近词、同形异义词等,达到简便记忆多个单词的目的,提高记忆效率,有助于解决 GRE 考生最头疼的单词问题。
