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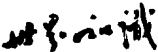
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前 言

几年前,当我考完 TOEFL、GRE 和计算机专项开始申请学校的时候,却突然发觉自己对美加学校了解得太少了。当时因特网并没有像现在一样普及,上网查询、收发 E-mail 都相当昂贵,惟一的信息来源就是去新东方阅览室查阅 Petersons Guide,找到学校网址和联系地址,然后再上网以节省钱,但是并不是每所你想联系的大学都在 Petersons Guide 上列出了其详细的联系地址,而且排队、查询加上复印是又花时间又花钱,当时一直想:为什么书店就没有一本详细介绍这方面的书呢?现在倒是不同了,走进任何一家书店,你都会发现一大堆诸如此类的书籍,而且往往是厚厚的一大本,但是如果仔细一瞧,你会发觉真正有用的东西并不多,看着许多同学像我当年一样花费大量的时间和来之不易的钱在寻找这些信息的时候,特别是下课以后许多同学围着问如何更好地得到这些信息的时候,我突然发觉非常有必要为大家把相关的信息收集起来,而且必须要按照专业来分才会更有用。

情况和具体的研究方向。我们本想列出教授的联系方法。但是事实上是你必须花费一定的时间去研究这个教授,对他有一定了解之后才能够与之联系,否则是达不到任何功效的,所以我们只列出了系的网址,你只要直接把它敲入计算机,点击 faculty member,就可以研究任何一位教授的详细信息,找到你需要的人选。

更详细地了解学校、专业和排名,结合自己的实际情况,诸如 TOEFL、GRE 成绩,GPA 和研究阅历,然后再决定自己该选择哪些学校是联系过程中重要的一步。我清楚地记得当年我们班里面共有 25 人联系,最后有 24 人拿到了奖学金,只有一人没有拿到,但是令人奇怪的是这个家伙的分数在我们班列前十名,TOEFL:657, GRE: 2250, computer 专项 98%,当时联系的时候我们没有人怀疑他拿不到奖学金,但是结局却令人失望,后来我们大伙分析得出结论:是他选择的学校和专业有问题,第二年策略一改,很快就去了 Washington。

出国留学是一个漫长而又艰辛的过程,获得高分当然是重要的,但是我认为写好 Personal Statement 和选择好学校和专业是最最主要的,我相信这本书一定会给你带来帮助。
