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内容提要

本书是根据"上海市经济委员会专业人员英语等级考试(EGT)大纲和样卷"一书而编写的,目的在于提供适当的资料和大量的练习,帮助读者复习和巩固已掌握的知识,并在此基础上得到进一步提高,以利于应试。

全书分两部分:Book One 供 C 级读者使用,内容为:词语与结构、阅读理解和连词成句。Book Two 供 A/B 级读者使用,内容为:词语与结构、完型填空、阅读理解和写作。附答案。

本书除供工程技术和经济专业人员准备等级考试使用外,还可供报考其它 标准化水平考试的读者及自学英语的读者用作学习材料。

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前言

本书是根据"上海市经济委员会专业人员英语等级考试 (EGT)大纲和样卷"一书而编写的,目的在于提供适当的资料 和大量的练习,帮助读者复习和巩固已掌握的知识,并在此基础上得到进一步提高,以利于应试。

本书特点:第一,应用性强,本书是针对上述考试大纲和样卷而编写的,故读者通过本书的学习,既可提高英语知识水平,增强阅读技能,又能熟悉等级考试的方法和要求,掌握应试技巧,提高应试能力;第二,内容丰富多样,由浅入深,重点突出,针对性强,可供不同水平的读者分别选用;第三,本书各项练习及文章等所用词语,除了个别的以外,绝大部分都选用大纲词汇表中的词语。在语法结构方面,重点放在读者感到困难的,且又在一般试题中经常出现的一些语法项目上面。对超前的或超大纲的词语附有注释。

全书分两册:Book One 供 C 级读者使用。内容分三部分:第一部分(Part I)词语与结构(Vocabulary and Structure),词语的练习共有 400 题;语法结构共分 6 节(详见本书目录);第二部分(Part I)阅读理解(Reading Comprehension),其中单句理解练习共 30 句,短文 23 篇;第三部分(Part I)连词成句(Sentence Making)共有 100 句连词成句练习。Book Two 供 A/B 级读者使用。内容分四部分:第一部分(Part I)词语与结构(Vocabulary and Structure),词语的练习共有 100 题;语法结构共分 9 节(详见本书目录);第二部分(Part I)完型填空(Cloze)共有短文 15 篇;第三部分(Part I)阅读理解(Reading Comprehension)共有短文 35 篇;第四部分(Part IV)写作(Writ-

ing)共有作文题目 11 个。

本书的 Book One 和 Book Two 是两大有机整体。C 级读者主要选读 Book One 的内容,但如果感到不足,也可选读 Book Two 中相应的内容。A/B 级读者在选读 Book Two 的同时,也必须掌握 Book One 的内容。本书附有全部练习答案和各作文题目的范文,供读者参考。

本书除供工程技术和经济专业人员准备等级考试使用外,还可供报考其它标准化水平考试的读者及自学英语的读者用作学习材料。
