编者的说明

《自学美语》(Teach Yourself American English Through Listening)是专为爱好美国英语的读者选编的。

近几年在我国的英语自学者中,特别是在青年英语爱好者中,不时地掀起一股小小的"美语热"。其中的一个重要原因就是美国英语听起来"潇洒大方,亲切自然",受到众多英语爱好者的青睐。为了使自学美语的读者能有机会听到地道的美语,从而能通过听学模仿,掌握美语的基本语音语调,编者收集了大量的美语录音磁带,从中精选出近 200 篇短文和对话,40 篇短篇小说,配以相应的练习,编辑成书,献给爱好美语的自学读者。

《自学美语》可用作自学美语的听力课本,也可用作各类英语短训班的听力训练课本或大专一、二年级课外听力教材。

本书的主要内容

《自学美语》全书分三册,每册 20 课,共 60 课。第一册每课含五篇短文,第二册每课含四篇短文或对话,第三册每课含两篇小说。每篇课文都配有详尽的词汇表和测试练习。所有课文录音都是纯正的美语,便于自学者听学模仿。各课课文的录音文字及练习答案排印在当课的练习之后,学习者可随时查对,十分方便。

第一册(Listen & Practice)为初级水平。课文以工作、职业、交际、朋友、聚会、娱乐、爱好等日常生活题材为主要内容。文字简短易懂,又联系生活实际,不仅好学,而且便于实际运用。每篇短文配有一篇口语或听力练习题。第五篇短文是听写练习。为了帮助初学者克服词汇困难,每篇练习之前都附有生词表,便利学习者在听录音之前先熟悉生词,减少听力障碍。

第二册(Listen & Learn)为中级水平。课文内容主要是美国城市介绍、旅游对话、幽默故事、科技报告等。课文的长度和难度较第一册略有增加。第二册中的生词表没有列在练习之前,而是列在课文的录音文字之前。也就是说自学者在做听力练习之前,见不到生词表。这样做,便于自学者检验自己的词汇量。有困难的读者可在做练习之前或做完练习之后查阅。

第三册(Listen & Enjoy)为初、中级水平。每课包含两个短篇故事。这些故事全部选自美国之音特别英语节目。故事文字简明易懂,情节生动感人。录音清晰,音质优美,并配有音响效果。这是一本具有永久保存和欣赏价值的精彩的有声读物。本书练习着重在对故事主要情节的掌握与理解。编者对故事中出现的难词难句都做了注释,以减少读者在理解上的困难。

怎样使用本书及录音?

所有听力练习必须坚持用耳朵解决问题。不要先行阅读录音文字。做练习时,一遍不能解决问题,可反复多听几遍。不要一遇到困难就翻阅录音课文。听是增长耳朵的"识别"能力和提高听力理解的唯一手段。切不要企图用眼睛来提高耳

朵的能力。

笔头练习只能起到检查听和听力理解水平的作用。若要提高说美语的水平,则需要反复地听,多次地模仿练习。语音语调的改进与提高主要靠模仿。在做完听力练习之后,应对照录音课文反复跟读模仿,直至可以正确地朗读背诵。本书所选的近 200 篇短文中,你若能模仿课文录音的语音语调背诵五六十篇,甚至上百篇,那么你的美语听起来就能以假乱真了。

第三册的短篇小说,每篇录音长度约 15 分钟。练习有一定的难度。听时必须精力高度集中。最好每次只听一篇。听完第一遍后做笔头或口头练习,也使精神稍稍放松一下,然后再集中精力听第二遍,着重听出第一遍听时遗漏的部分。听第三遍时不妨对照课文,边听边看。连续听两三遍效果必定不好。
