前 言

《大学涉外英语听说教程》是根据国家教委颁布的《大学英语教学大纲》和大学涉外专业本科毕业生在工作岗位上对英语听说能力的特别需要而精心设计和编写的。在长期的教学实践中我们发现,大学涉外专业学生在使用普通听力口语教材后,日常听说能力有所提高,但涉及到一些对外事务时,如法律、经济、金融、教育、体育等方面,都感到在听力理解和口头表达上力不从心。为此我们确定了按主题选材,遵循交际教学法和翻译教学法原则的编写方案。

本教程按主题分类设置单元。全书包括 10 个主题 20 个单元,每个主题包括两个单元。每单元由三部分组成:Part A Aural and Oral Preparations; Part B Conversations; Part C Passages。每单元 4 小时完成,全书总课时为 80 小时。

我们在编写过程中强调了所选主题与各大专院校开设的涉外专业的相关性,同时也注意了教程难度的把握。本教程主要为大学英语三、四级涉外专业本科生使用,也可供一般本科专业学生在大学英语五、六级阶段选用。

我们希望本教程能为全国大学英语上新台阶尽绵薄之力。书中不足之处,恳请同行、专家批评指正。

本教程在编写过程中得到了武汉大学教务处,武汉大学英语教学部和武汉大学出版社的大力支持,在此深表谢意。
