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前言

本书是根据1994年最新修订的《大学英语教学大纲通用词汇表》(1~4级)编写的, 共收录了900题, 分为18套测试卷。 每套共50题, 由两部分构成: Part I 为30个填空选择题. Part II 为20个同义词选择题。

编者根据全国大学英语四级统考词汇部分的试题设计思路,并针对学生在学习和应考中所遇到的各种困难,编写了此书,旨在帮助学生在统考前复习、巩固、测试四级要求的词汇。书中每套测试卷所涉及的词汇基本覆盖A~Z为词首的词汇范围,因此都能独立使用。此外,本书还附有试题注释,对难度较大的题目标以*符,在书后予以详解。书后还提供每套测试卷的答案,为学生自学提供了方便。

此书还能帮助学生更多地学习、掌握词汇的多种词义和用法。 因此,不仅是四级统考的必备之书,也能作为报考六级英语学生及英语自学者的练习用书。
