

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### 英语考试应试手册 A Workbook For ETCE

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#### 前言

近年来,成人高等教育逐渐兴起,为成年人接受高层次教育创造了良好的条件,但英语学科的教学一直是个难点,尤其是 1991 年起实行统一的学位英语考试更使学生感到困难甚大,不知如何应付。《英语考试应试手册》(以下简称《手册》)正是为解决这方面的问题而编写的。

《手册》是根据上海市成人高等本科教育非英语专业《英语教育大纲》及学位英语考试样题编写的,旨在通过大量的练习,帮助读者复习、巩固和提高英语语言知识,并熟悉学位英语考试的方法和要求,掌握应试技巧,提高应试能力。

《手册》分为 9 个部分。第一部分语法结构,6 个练习,430 题,第二部分词汇,2 个练习,425 题;第三部分辨错,155 题;第四部分完形填空,10 篇短文,200 题;第五部分阅读理解,30 篇短文,150 题;第六部分英译汉,10 篇短文,每篇需翻译 5处(划线标明),共 50 题;第七部分汉译英,125 题;第八部分模拟题,共 2 套;第九部分成人学位英语考试样卷。书末附有参考答案。

《手册》有以下特点:

- 1. 选材广泛,体裁多样,注意知识性、趣味性、实用性;
- 2. 练习根据教学大纲和考试样题编写,实用性强,覆盖面广。模拟试题的形式、题量、计时、计分与样题和正式考题完全一致,难度也基本相同;
  - 3. 编排合理,由浅入深,重点突出,既有分类练习,也有综合练习,
- 4. 各类练习和文章所用词语尽可能限制在大纲词汇表内,对超出 大纲范围的词语凡影响答题的均注明汉语词义;
  - 5. 附练习答案,供读者参考。

《手册》不仅适于成人高等本科教育非英语专业学生,对自学考试

生和申请报考中级职称英语考试的各类人员也大有裨益。

《手册》的初稿在华东政法学院 92 届(华东六省一市)夜大、函授本科生中使用过,教学效果和考试结果均很理想。

限于水平,《手册》中的不足之处,敬请读者指正。
