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内 容 提 要

为了帮助参加 TOEFL/EPT 等标准化英语考试的考生解决应用文阅读理解的困难,本书从原版材料中选取了各种应用文128篇,内容涉及广告、说明书、保修单、合同、目录、图书资料等共十四大类。在每种类型文章前均列出要点或缩略词等,书末附有全部题目的详解答案。

本书可供参加各种英语标准化考试的考生使用,也可供广大的英语爱好者参考。

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前言

参加 TOEFL/EPT 考试的考生遇到的困难之一就是应用 文的阅读理解。这一部分在考试中所占比重不是很大,但考生如不得要领,丢分很多,往往令人遗憾。本书编写的目的,就是为了有效地帮助考生解决这一难题,考试中取得高分,到国外学习、生活顺利。

应用文阅读理解的难关何在?本人认为难点有两个:对各种不同应用文的基本结构不了解;不认识应用文中常用的缩略词。解决了这两个问题,困难就会迎刃而解。为此,在每章(某种应用文)的开头先列出这种文章的要点(main points),必要时给出常用的缩略词(语)。如以上两点仍不能帮助你彻底解决疑难,本书附有全部题目的详解答案。这些详解不仅能帮助你做对答案,更重要的是可以帮助你真正理解文章本身,增长知识,达到一举两得的目的。

本书的读者对象是:

- 1. 有志在 TOEFL、EPT 及各种标准化考试中取得优 异 成 绩者。
- 2. 有志研究英语应用文以利自己的工作者。
- 3. 进一步完善自己的英语,扩大当代信息摄取量,从而在事业竞争中取胜者。
