

出版说明

《每日英语》讲座节目在中国北京、上海、广州、西安、河北、长春、天津、江苏、甘肃、福建等地播出以来,受到了广大英语听众的欢迎。应广大听众要求,北京人民广播电台和加拿大国际广播电台就举办连续性讲座节目进行了研究与协商,决定联合举办《每日英语续集》讲座节目,由加拿大国际广播电台组织编写、录制,北京人民广播电台以及上述各地广播电台组织在当地播出。

《每日英语续集》(Everyday English—Series II and III) 分上、下两册出版,上册(Everyday English Series II)内容以中国留学生在加拿大的生活、学习和工作为主线,广泛涉及了加拿大的风俗习惯、风土人情和文化背景;下册(Everyday English Series III) 广泛涉及了有关专业领域如电讯、政府、农业等等各行各业的语言和词汇。此外,每课还配有对话和英文歌曲。

《每日英语续集》适合基础较好的高中生、大专院校学生,以及具有中级或中级以上英语水平的工人、干部、解放军、医务人员、科技人员、外事人员、教师、新闻工作者等学习。

为配合讲座的播出,给广大读者、听众提供学习上的便利,北京人民广播电台还组织编写了《每日英语续集上册辅导手册》(下册没有辅导手册),并制做了《每日英语续集课文朗读磁带》,由本社出版发行。

PARAGRAPH INTRO FOR EE II AND III

The response to **Everyday English**, Radio Canada International's first English language course broadcast in China, has been overwhelming. All over China, but especially in the cities of Beijing, Xian, Shanghai and Guangzhou where the series was first broadcast, listeners took to their hearts the slogan "Everyday is the way!" and applied themselves to the study of English. They discovered what we had hoped they would discover: that learning a language can be entertaining as well as instructive. At the same time, they learned something of Canada, our customs and culture.

Everyday English—Series II and III maintains and enhances this objective. Again, it is aimed at the advanced-intermediate to advanced level language learner. Series II was produced by RCI in conjunction with The China Project Office at St. Mary's University, Halifax and consists of 40 half-hour lessons that convey information about Canadian lifestyles and customs. The 40 half-hours that comprise Series III provide the listener with more variety, more informal
