

# 前 言

《基础英语》为我国高等学校英语专业教材。全书四册,供两学年使用。《基础英语》第二册(上)(听力·口语分册),为《基础英语》第二册的第一分册(另一分册为阅读·写作部分),供高等学校英语专业一年级下学期使用。

第二册仍然遵循了第一册前言中所阐述的编写原则,编排体例也与第一册大体相同,只是适当增加了练习的分量和难度。本分册共收未学过的词、语 283 项。不包含生词的短语大都采用英语注释,其他词、语则采用汉语注释,纤增加了一些词语用法的注释(用星号"\*"表示)。

这一分册的两个部分各十六课,每周上课时间大致可作如下安排:

听力 2课时(最好分两次上) 口语 4课时(分两次上)






