#### 致 教 师

"语法隐形,功能为纲"是新课程标准的一大特点。这对于中小学英语教师来说,是一个普遍感到头痛的问题。很多人都有这样一个疑问:英语课到底要不要教语法?我们认为,回答是肯定的。问题是如何教才能更好地既突出语言的交际功能,又能使语法知识"内化"成正确应用语言的能力。事实上,高考英语试题并非不考语法,也并非只拘泥于四选一的语法试题,而是将语法渗透在整个高考英语试题之中。其中,听力、完形填空、阅读理解和短文改错都需要用扎实的语法基础知识来分析句子结构及整体意思,而英语写作则更是需要主动地运用语法规则来达到遣词造句的目的。

语法学习,精讲为纲,训练为主。为了让学生在较短时间内较好地掌握英语语言,了解英语语言的内在规律,提高学生英语语法学习的效率,我们编写了《高中英语语法"四维"随堂高效满分训练与测试》。本书可独立使用,也可配合《高考英语语法名师大串讲》使用。具有如下特点:

第一,坚持"系统、实用、适用"的编写理念。既保持语法系统本身所具有的知识板块的完整性,又避免面面俱到;突出重点、突破难点、凸显考点,注重知识与能力的结合、方法与策略的引导,全面提升学生的备考能力。对于非毕业班的学生,可以结合教材的使用,教师采用"练习——讲评——查补"的方式提升其效果;对于毕业班学生,教师可根据本班学生的实际情况,就某些章节有选择性地训练,但应注意"精讲精练",突出"释疑、解难"。

第二,坚持"服务一线"的主导思想。是由奋战在一线教学的名家、名师亲自执笔,充分吸收一线教师教学的精华,形成的一套成熟高效的学习和复习的备考资料,同时又用以指导一线的教学和备考,是教师备课、学生自学、复习备考的好帮手。

第三,坚持"以人为本"的指导思想。我们在总结教学实践经验的基础上,全面分析、科学归类、合理提炼,梳理出了大纲要求学生必须掌握的基础知识和主干知识,分别设计经典测试题,分基础练习、提高练习、拓展练习、高考链接四层,适合不同层次的学生在不同复习阶段根据自己的需要实施诊断、拓展、提高或实战训练。

第四,坚持"层次分明,多角度训练"的原则。按"基础练习""提高练习""拓展练习"和"高考链接"四级编写,由易到难,由简单到综合,由靶式练习到真题体验。"靶式练习"体现了全方位综合演练,"高考真题"实为零距离接触高考,注重了学生思维品质和综合能力的提升,便于诊断检测与评价。

总之,本书以《全日制义务教育 普通高级中学 英语课程标准(实验稿)》所要求的 24 个语法项目为基础编写而成,能满足全国各地的高考和平时学习的需求。我们真诚希望此书能够成为同学们的好搭档、好帮手,使同学们能够轻松掌握高中英语语法,从容应对高考!

不过,本书在资料收集上工作量很大,缺点与错误在所难免,希望广大师生在使用时提出宝贵的修改意见,以期此书更加完善。
