

写到了《一口气英语》第四册,愈写感触愈深,愈觉得有使命感,一定要在有生之年 完成这项任务 使有心学英文的人,不再痛苦,让大家有好的教材,可以一步一步地向前迈进。

我们过去所用的英语教材、教法,全部都错了,学生痛苦,没兴趣,英文老师更痛苦,每天教那些没有生命的东西。最后,老师和学生都对英文失去兴趣,觉得要把英文说好,像是不可能的目标。编者也是一样,曾经教英语会话十多年,刚开始当老师真高兴,充满热忱,以为教了英语会话,自己的英语会话一定会变好。结果,随着时间的增加,热忱逐渐消失。

很多人英文学不好,都说没有英语环境、没有外国老师,其实,很多到美国的移民,一生苦学英文,到死以前,还是没能学好英文,他们说出来的话,被美国人戏称是 Chinglish(中国式英语)。虽然在美国长期居住,今天东学一句,明天西学一句,学的都是模模糊糊的东西,学得模糊,说得也模糊,天天说英文,却不知道自己说得对不对,说起英语来,当然没有信心。

一口气英语 把美国口语的精华 一句一句 一回一回 一册一册地烙印在读者的脑海中 你讲的每一句话,都是经过研究,精心编排过的,背得滚瓜烂熟以后,说出来的话,当然有信心。

编者研究一辈子的英文语法,现在发现,学生实在 不应该先学语法,语**言应该回归自然** 只要背美国人平 常所说的话,就行了。

美国人平常所说的话,和他们所写出来的不一样,他们写得正式严谨,讲得幽默轻松,那些写会话书的美国人,都是学了不少语法,他们往往不敢将他们平常讲的话,付诸于文字,例如,美国人常说: I'm done. (我做完了。) I'm finished. (我做完了。) 会话书中,却避而不写。

编者年轻的时候,到美国读书,听到美国同学问: "Are you all packed?"(你的行李是不是都打好包了?) 这句话在书上,美国人只敢写出"Have you packed?" (你的行李打好包了吗?)当你听到很多的话和你学的不一样,你讲起话来就没有信心了。

编者已在台湾各个学校演讲《一口气英语》许多次,深深地感受到学生学习的痛苦和老师教英语的困难,也感受到,有了《一口气英语》,学好英语不再是少数人的专利,什么都不要管 只要背就行了 人人都能够背,人人都能够学好英文。

当编者看到了老师和学生兴奋的表情,及充满希望的目光,深感责任重大,我们决心尽一切力量,把《一口气英语》继续写下去。

I'm flying to New York.

(我要搭飞机去纽约。)

I want to go to New York.

(我想要去纽约。)

I'd like to fly to New York.

I plan to fly out next Friday.

(我打算下星期五搭飞机走。)【fly out 搭机离去】

I plan to go next Friday. (我打算下星期五去。) I plan to take off next Friday.

(我打算下星期五出发。)【take off 离开(=leave)】

如果说"我这星期五走。"英文就是:

I'm leaving Friday.
I'm leaving on Friday.
I'm leaving this Friday.

I want to go business class.
