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前言

(FOREWORD)

随着职业教育形势的不断变化,如何适应新形势、新情况,也就成了很实际的 问题。

最近几年,职业学校实行了提前招生,即提前招收初中生,每年在五月初进入 职业学校学习,这给职业学校提出了实实在在的问题:提前招收的学生文化课教 材如何选用?

学校曾经考虑沿用初中的教材,却有"炒冷饭"之嫌;启用职业学校高一教材, 又将出现新问题,新学期教学计划将被打乱,或者说教学时间有多余。通过几次 考虑,终于下决心组织编写初中·中职衔接教材。这便是编写这套教材的初衷。 如何确定内容呢?我们认为必须符合提前招生的实际。提前招生的劣势是学生 的语文、数学和英语三门文化课基础不够扎实。根据这种特殊性,我们编写的时候突出了基础性和趣味性。

本教材内容以日常生活话题为主线,重视对学生英语学习兴趣的培养,选材多样,知识性、趣味性、实用性并重。教材内容贴近现代生活,富有教学生活化、基础性强、易学好用、体现素质教育和以人为本的教育理念,突出职业教育特色,培养学生英语交际能力。

本教材有如下特点:

- (1)以"零"为起点,但也不是完全从 ABC 开始,而是从学生的生活情景出发, 鼓励学生主动参与,在不断操练中提高英语会话能力,起到初中、中职学生学习英语知识的衔接作用。
- (2)教材教学内容生活化。每单元的话题实用性强,并且配有许多图片,使刚 人职校的学生产生学习英语的兴趣,重新树立学好英语的信心。
- (3) 根据学生的认知规律和语言学习规律,引导他们调整学习方法。结合国际音标教学,使学生巩固英语基础知识,发展听、说、读、写的基本技能,为今后的继续学习打下基础。
- (4)教材突出职业教育特色。让学生进行大量的模仿训练,以帮助学生克服 语音障碍,注重学生运用所学语言开展有效交际的技能。



教材体系及课时安排建议如下:

本教材共10单元,每单元围绕一个交际话题展开,包括热身、对话(会话)、听力训练、语音学习、课文阅读、单词和短语、注释、练习等部分。每单元4课时,每 个任务(task)安排一个课时,也可以由教师根据学生实际情况灵活调整。每课时都配有课时练习,每单元的第四课时为单元练习,以巩固本单元所学知识。每单元4课时具体安排如下:

- Task 1: (Warming-up, Dialogues, Conversation, New words and expressions, Notes, Exercises for task 1)
- Task 2: (Practise speaking, Listening, Pronunciation, Exercises for task 2)
- Task 3: (Before you read, While you read, After you read, New words and expressions, Notes, Exercises for task 3)
- Task 4: (Exercises for the unit)





Notes

- 1. 在英语国家,人们一般不直呼全名(full name),或姓(last/family name, surname),而是以名(first name) 相称,以示友好。亲人、同事、朋友或师生都可直呼名。
- 2. How do you do? 是两人初次见面时的问候语。回答也是 How do you do?
- 3. How are you? 和 Fine, thanks. And you? 是与人打招呼时的用语, 其目的是拓展对话,而不是问候身体是否健康。
- 4. So is England. 意思是"英国也一样(如此)"。句型"So+系动词 be/助动词/情态动词+主语"表示前文提到过的事情,也同样适合下文的人或事物。注意: 此句型用于肯定句中。本文中 So is England. 根据意思是England is really beautiful, too.
 - e.g. She is from America. So is Mary. (= Mary is from America, too.)

 My sister enjoys traveling. So do 1. (= I enjoy traveling, too.)
