## **1小时1句型训练法：**

### **第一步 单词点拨**

先花5分钟时间，将单词录音跟读几遍，大致掌握本课中要用到的新单词。

### **第二步 句型裂变**

接下来的8分钟，一口气学完句型裂变中的前5句，两个人练习时可以一人念英文，一人念中文，直到滚瓜烂熟后再学后5句。

### **第三步 模仿改错**

练习对话时，最好的办法是老师先请学生扮演角色，并指出学生发音中的错误和不足，然后再听录音，并模仿；每课5个对话大概需要25分钟的时间。

### **第四步 感受句型**

请同学上台再次扮演角色，让同学们身临其境，感受句型使用的场合，可以用10分钟的时间来做这个练习。

### **第五步 互动会话**

剩下的12分钟，我们要做的是：在课文中找出单词点拨中的新单词，并熟记这些句子；两个人一组，请同学们把句型裂变中前5句没有对话的句子组成对话。

本书的英文部分由文化造诣较高的美国专家编写，因此语言质量可靠，内容完全来自于美国人的日常生活对话，简洁、精练，也易懂易记，你曾卡壳的一句说不定就在其中。

最后我们编写者想说的是，真正意义上属于我们的成功是——读者认为我们的书是最好的，是一半成功；读者将书中的内容真正掌握，将其变成自己的一笔财富，是另一半成功！
