前言

英语是当今世界上最主要的国际通用语言之一,世界上约有80多个国家把英语作为官方语言或第二语言。世界上80%以上的邮件是用英文书写的;全世界科技出版物70%以上用英语发表;全世界的广播节目中,有60%是用英语进行广播的;绝大部分的国际会议是以英语为第一通用语言。随着我国对外开放的不断扩大,经济文化交流的不断发展,学好英语具有重要的现实意义和深远的历史意义。在人际交往中,无论是在职场、社交、贸易领域,还是在文化交流活动中,英语已经成了一种必要的交流工具。熟练地掌握英语,已经成为现代人必备的素质。
