前言

本书特色

1. 遴选词汇,精益求精

考虑到 MBA 考生兼职备考的现实处境,笔者依据最新大纲和历年考试真题,精心遴选出核心词汇近 2800 个,大大减轻学员的备考负担,提升学员词汇方面的备考效率。

2. 单词释义,简洁有序

词汇的释义言简意赅,重点突出;义项的排列科学有序,基本是从本义过渡到引申义,做到既知其"根",又洞悉词义之间的联系。这一方面符合记忆规律,另一方面有助于考生在不同语境中灵活理解,大大提升了阅读和翻译能力。

3. 搭配用法,明晰洗练

对单词常见的搭配、用法以及派生词,笔者也从相关出处作了精心的选摘和加工,让考生在记词的同时,了解用法,熟悉语境,彻底摆脱"只知词义,不知使用"的尴尬局面。

4. 所附例句,经典适用

所列词汇的每个释义均给出经典例句,例句主要来源于《朗文当代高级英语辞典》、《牛津高阶英汉双语词典》以及《英汉大词典》等公认权威词典,使学员在阅读语境中科学背词,以达到活学活用之目的。

5. 翻译写作,一步到位

经典适用的例句配以准确流畅的翻译,使得考生一方面可以深化对单词的理解;另一方面也可以此为契机,作英汉互译的练习,在实践中巩固词汇、熟化词汇,与此同时提升自己的英译汉和写作(汉翻英)能力。

6. 真题再现,强化重点

众所周知,在标准化的语言测试中,尤其是词汇题目,会出现所谓的"马太效应",即越常考的(对象)越会考。纵观历年 MBA 联考英语试题,这种现象尤为明显,重点的、常见的词义会反复考查。有鉴于此,笔者将近九年的词汇题目精心摘录,添加在所考核词汇的注解下面,使得考生复习更具针对性,以提高应试效率。

本书导读

1. 重复记忆是"硬道理"

学习词汇,如同交友,一回生,二回熟。从理解、记忆,到会用词汇,需要反复接触,反复练习。初学者都希望别人告诉自己窍门或捷径。但"死"记"硬"背、大量重复是必经之路。想不费工夫就能记牢单词,恐怕是徒劳的。

2. 语境背词, 事半功倍

英语单词往往具有一词多义和一词多性现象,不仅如此,在不同的上下文语境中,还会有灵活的引申或外延。所以,任何一个单词都不可能是几个汉字能解释清楚的,英语和汉语

永远不可能完全对等。之所以很多考生常常感叹"文章无生词,不解文章意",就是因为他们所背的词汇仍然是词汇书的机械含义,脱离了实际的语言环境,不能真正做到学以致用。这就要求考生一定要对大纲中的词汇做到深度理解,重视例句的研读和学习。

3. 立体式背单词

有的考生为了追求词汇数量,总想着一举拿下大纲的 5800 个单词,而蜻蜓点水似的背词汇表,乍看好像见效很快,实际上却是掩耳盗铃、自欺欺人。不知发音已是一大缺陷(听说将成无源之水),不了解词汇的使用更是留下了隐患(阅读写作失去了保障),这就是为什么单词背了 N 遍,自我感觉良好,而考试成绩却总让人绝望的根本原因。所以单词学习必须采用"音、形、意、用"相结合的立体式策略。

下面就单词用法的重要性举两个例子,考生可细细体会:

The most important argument for a broad education is that in studying the accumulated wisdom of the ages, we improve our moral sense.

译文:进行广泛教育的最重要理由是通过研究人类多年积累的智慧,我们提升了自己的道德感。

注释: argument 有"争执,论点,论据"的意思,但在此处考生一定要注意以下几点: argument 后面接了介词 for,形成特定的搭配("支持……的论据");前面有最高级修饰语 the most important(故理解为"论点"不太合适);此外,此句语体风格是典型的书面语(有表语从句),而"争执,争吵"往往出现在口语语体的表达中。综上所述,此句中的 argument 只能理解为"论据",再结合汉语表达的顺畅要求,灵活地译为"理由"。

From the demonstration of a principle to the marketing of products derived from that principle is often a long, involved series of steps.

译文:从原理的演示到基于此项原理的产品的上市销售,往往要经过一系列漫长复杂的步骤。

注释:此句中的 marketing, 部分同学读到后的第一反应是"市场", 但却忽视了后缀 - ing; 基于语法原理, 加了 - ing 后缀的英语单词应是动词词义, 所以此处 marketing 的正确 理解应该是动词含义"上市销售", 而不是纯名词含义"市场"。

4. "学""习"结合,相辅相成

"学"指的是知识的理解和记忆,"习"指的是实践中的练习和应用。"习"是"学"的目的,但反过来亦可巩固"学"的效果,两者相互促进,相辅相成。具体到词汇学习上,考生应该"学"单词的同时,重视"习"的作用。具体而言,考生可试着把例句翻译成汉语,然后对比所给译文,进行比较,找出理解和翻译上的不足。过一段时间后,可将背过单词的汉语译文回译成英文,一方面可巩固记忆所背单词,另一方面练习了句式写作能力。通过本书数以千计例句的互译,考生可大大提升自己的翻译和写作能力,单词的记忆亦水到渠成。

鉴于时间仓促,作者仍处于探索完善阶段,纰漏瑕疵之处在所难免,敬请广大读者、英语 界同仁批评指正。
