Preface

As an important academic branch of Chinese *tuina*, pediatric *tuina* has developed its own system due to its unique theories and principles and it is honored as 'a magic therapy for nursing the children' due to its significant efficacy. It is really an effective recipe for treating pediatric diseases and the treasure of Chinese medicine as well.

Classic of Pediatric Tuina (Xiaoer Anmo Jing, 小儿按摩经) records pediatric tuing as 'a magic therapy that substitutes the acupuncture by hand manipulations'. This therapy originated from the instinctive and deep parental love of caring and hugging their children. There are oracle bone inscriptions about tuina as early as in the Yin and Shang periods (1766-1122 B.C.). Later, the application and development of pediatric tuina were documented in classics such as Recipes for 52 Kinds of Disorders (52 Binafana, 52 病方) in the Spring and Autumn and Warring States Periods, as well as Inner Classic (Neijing, 内经), Shennong's Classic of Materia Medica (Shennong Bencao Jing, 神农本草经), Essential Prescriptions Worth a Thousand Gold (Qianjin Yaofang, 千金要方), and Complete Record of Sacred Benevolence (Shengji Zonglu, 圣济总录) during and after the Qin and Han dynasties. To the middle time of Ming dynasty, the release of Classic of Pediatric Tuina (Xiaoer Tuina Jing, 小儿推拿经) and Complete Book of Secret Principles of Pediatric Tuina Recipes on Nurturing Infant (Xiaoer Tuina Fangmai Huoyin Mizhi Quanshu, 小儿推拿方脉活婴秘旨全 #3) declared the forming of academic system of pediatric tuina, which contributed greatly to the thriving of the Chinese nation. Since the reform and opening of China, many scholars of Western medicine and even some proficient foreign pediatric experts, no matter by meeting them when I was lecturing abroad or by receiving them

domestically, knew little or nothing about pediatric *tuina*, but were all surprised to see the marvelous pediatric *tuina*. Pediatric *tuina* is really a great invention of Chinese medicine.

Ge Mei-fei, the author, is the China's first batch of outstanding female physicians of Chinese medicine. Since she graduated from Shandong College of Traditional Chinese Medicine, she has involved in the pediatric department for more than twenty years. She was once an apprentice of Pro. Xu Jin-xiang, a famous and accomplished pediatric expert of the combination of Chinese and Western medicine. 本书比较完整地介绍了小儿推拿学的学术体系,深入浅出,图文并茂,力求准确、实用。第一章小儿推拿概述,介绍小儿推拿的发展更和近现代著名小儿推拿流派,并展望了小儿推拿的发展前景;第二章小儿推拿基本理论,着重介绍小儿推拿的作用原理、小儿的生理病理和病因特点以及儿科推拿的四诊、辨证要点与处方规律,第三章小儿推拿基本知识,主要介绍小儿推拿临诊时的手法特点、常用介质、适应证与禁忌证和各项临床须知等基本知识;第四章小儿推拿基本技能,重点介绍各种推拿的具体手法和操作要点;第五章常见病治疗,介绍了十四种儿科常见病的推拿临床治疗;第六章小儿保健推拿,介绍了六种行之有效的小儿保健推拿方法。

本书全文汉英对照,适用于国内外小儿推拿的爱好者与初学者,也可作为推拿专业学员和医务人员的专业英语读本。由于本人水平有限,书中难免有不少缺点和错误,请广大读者批评和指正。

Foreword

Tuina, a very ancient modality of treating diseases, did coexist with the civilization history of human beings and play an indelible role in resisting diseases. However, due to the introduction and spread of modern medicine in the recent period and with the occurrence and application of antibiotics and other biomedicines, people became aware that many acute and infectious diseases could be effectively controlled and treated, while the treatment attained from Chinese medicine including tuina was neglected at some extent, especially in the pediatric field. As the time moves forward, some deficits of the biomedicine, such as biomedical toxic and side effects, profuse occurrence of drug-fast bacteria and continuously increased incidence rate of nonorganic disorders, gradually appear and it makes the people take prudent thoughts on both the Chinese and Western medicines, rediscovering the Western medicine and the shining points of Chinese medicine. In recent years, people start to advocate holistic concept in treatment as well as natural therapies. Tuina as a main part of the natural therapies is destined to receive more and more concerns.

This book systematically introduces the academy of pediatric *tuina* with illustrations, aiming for accurate, practical and understandable. The first chapter summarizes pediatric *tuina* by introducing its history and famous schools in the modern times as well as its prospect in the future. The second chapter is about the basic theory of pediatric *tuina*, which focuses on the action mechanism of pediatric *tuina*, physiological, pathological and etiological features of pediatrics, and four examinations, key points of pattern identification and formula disciplines. The third chapter, basic knowledge of pediatric *tuina*, mainly illustrates its basic clinical

knowledge of manipulation characteristics, commonly used mediums, indications, contraindications and some clinical instructions. The fourth chapter, basic techniques of pediatric *tuina*, emphasizes the specific operating manipulations and essentials of operation. The fifth chapter, treatment on common diseases, lists clinical treatment of *tuina* on fourteen kinds of common pediatric diseases. The sixth chapter, pediatric *tuina* for healthcare, presents six methods of effective pediatric *tuina* for healthcare.

This book is a Chinese-English edition that facilitates amateurs and beginning learners of pediatric *tuina* both from home and abroad. It can also be used as a special English version for *tuina* learners and practitioners. Inevitably, there should be flaws and mistakes in the book and I sincerely welcome all your recommendations and criticisms.
