


Fig. 8 Portrait of Confucius




Fig. 13 A Painting of Wang Zhaojun's Marriage Outside the Great Wall




Fig. 18 Goguryeo Wall Painting of the Hunting Scene




Fig. 21 Kublai Khan Hunting




Fig. 22 Cold Forest and Mountains by Li Cheng
