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
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

Keai: But I want to go into the city and have a look at the blue sky.



I can't wait to see you guys.

我迫不及待想见你们。

I can't wait to go to the ball.

我迫不及待想去舞会。

I can't wait to grow up quickly.

我迫不及待想快点长大。

Hurry up

Hurry up 表示"快点,赶紧"。通常用在祈使句中,要求别人快点。例如: Hurry up, otherwise you can't go to school on time.


快点,不然你就不能按时到校了。

I can hardly wait to tell you the truth.


我迫不及待想告诉你真相。

我迫不及待想看看她的新礼服。


I can hardly wait to listen to my grandpa's funny stories.

Rose: Thank you, darling. I can't wait to start our



和可爱: 我们出机场后去逛街怎么样?




Yingjun: Are you a super girl? Aren't you tired? I won't do anything except sleep.
