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出版者的话

随着我国对外开放政策的顺利贯彻,国内参加托福考试的人数逐年增加,因而从事研究或辅导托福考试的外语教学工作者也不乏其人。书店里各种版本的托福考试辅导材料也不少,但对历年托福考试作系统研究的却不多。《托福历年常考句型分析》一书将一九六〇年至一九八五年托福考试的310种常考句型加以科学整理,并按字母顺序排列,便于查找。每一句型的例句简明恰当,能使读者充分了解每一句型的用法及其变化规律,便于记忆和运用。

经过半年多来在考生中的试用,通过学习书中的综合分析,使学生把答题技巧上升到一般语言规律,不仅提高了应试能力,又可较迅速地提高语言水平。

因此,本书可作为报考美国、加拿大、澳大利亚等国硕士研究生参加托福考试的参考书,也是报考国内VST和国内硕士研究生极有价值的一本实用的辅导材料,对于大学本科学子掌握英语语法和教师在教学过程中作为参考资料都有较大的价值。

在出版过程中我们对每一句型和例句又逐一进行了审核,有些例句的内容不完全适合我国的社会情况,为保持原书的完整性,未进行删节和更改。

本书由吴佩先生编著,由台湾省文鹤出版有限公司出版。因客观条件限制,在翻印之前无法与作者本人及原出版社取得联系,我们将为作者保留稿酬和样书。

本書根據編者多年教授托福課程之經驗及研究整理歷年托福考題之心得著成。編寫力求條理清晰、分析詳盡，並把握要點，以期幫助讀者瞭解托福測驗之動向，在最短時間之內，收事半功倍之效。

本書具有下列特點：

- 1 將歷屆托福常考句型，依字母順序排列，以便讀者查閱。
- 2 例句簡明恰當，使讀者充分瞭解各句型之用法，便於記憶與活用。
- 3 托福出題之方式，一一指明，以訓練讀者之答題技巧，並節省作答之時間。
- 4 句型每告一段落，附有模擬歷屆托福考題之測驗練習，以供讀者研習之用。

托福歷年考過之句型，以及以後可能出現之新句型，本書逐一作深入淺出之探討。讀者所讀本書之後，不但可以獲得理想之考試成績，並且可以增進英文閱讀與寫作之能力。

本書原稿，編者曾數次修訂，惟匆促付梓，錯誤難免，尚祈讀者不吝指正，是所感盼。
