# 序

很高兴为蔡炳冲老师的专著《中学英语相关动词辨异》作序。

英语中有大量意义相近或结构相似的动词，它们中有些虽可表示同一概念，但在语义、情感、语体或搭配上存在着一定的差别；有些看来同义，却侧重不一，用法各异；有些似乎相像，但词性和词义迥然不同。因此，如何掌握这类动词历来是英语学习中的一个难点。为帮助学生较好地解决这一问题，蔡炳冲老师在认真研究和实践的基础上，以大纲为依据，从教学的实际出发，编写了这本《中学英语相关动词辨异》。

本书收录英语中常见的相关动词 279 组，并通过辨义、举例和注释揭示各组词语在意义和用法上的异同。辨义部分讲解清晰，详略得当，着重点出可能造成误解、误用之所在；举例部分句子通顺，语言地道，大多选自国内外教材和词典；注释部分叙述简要，重点突出，多为值得引起注意的要点或为辨义部分的拓展延伸与必要补充。

总的来说，《中学英语相关动词辨异》一书具有很强的针对性、指导性和实用性，对于正确理解和使用词语、提高阅读和写作水平很有裨益，不失为广大学生必读、教师必备的一本好书。

# A

## 1. accept/receive

**accept** “接受”;它所表示的这种行为是经过思考的主观意愿决定的。例如：

*I cannot accept your apology.* 我不能接受你的道歉。

*He always accepts criticism with an open mind.* 他总是虚心接受批评。

注：accept 还可表示“接受(吸收)入党(团)”。例如：

*In 1960 Lei Feng was accepted as a Party member.* 1960 年雷锋被接纳为共产党员。

**receive** “接到”,“收到”,“受到”;它只强调收到某某东西的动作行为。例如：

*When did you receive the letter?* 你什么时候接到这封信的?

*I received an invitation yesterday, but I did not accept it.* 昨天我收到一份请帖,但并没有接受它。(即:仅仅是收到的动作,而未同意去赴约。)

注① receive 是终止性动词,其完成时不能同表示一段时间的状语连用。如不能说:I have received your letter for five days. 应该说:

I received your letter five days ago.

注② receive 还有“遭受”、“接待”之意。例如:

*Suddenly, he received a heavy blow on the head.* 突然,他头部挨了重一击。
