出版说明

为了配合高中英语总复习,提高考生的英语语言能力和应试能力, 根据 1996 年高考英语改革的新精神,我们组织编写了这本书。

从高中毕业班学生的英语现状和实际需要出发,本书包括分项技能训练和高考模拟试题。分项技能训练练习题在内容和形式上根据国家教委有关高考英语的基本要求编排,注意了复习、巩固基础知识与培养、提高各种语言能力相结合,全面系统地复习与突出重点和难点相结合,类型多样,内容丰富,涉及面广,实用性强。6 套模拟试题在试卷结构、题型和考查范围等方面均参照近年来,特别是 1996 年普通高等学校招生全国统一考试英语试题,对考生检查、巩固和提高所学知识,提高解题能力和应试能力,都有较大的帮助。另外,我们还附上了 1994 年、1995 年和1996 年三年的高考试题,供大家参考。

本书的编者为北京师大附属实验中学、北京师大一附中、北京师大二附中和清华附中的高级教师,他们长期从事高中英语教学、高考复习、高考命题研究以及高考辅导材料的编写工作。本书是他们多年经验的提炼。

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分项技能训练

I. 单项填空

单项填空用于考查考生的英语基础知识和基本能力,包括语音、语法、习惯表达和情景对话等内容,具有覆盖面广,信息量大,考试重点突出,易于操作,节省时间的特点。考生可以在进行全面综合复习前先分门别类地做一些单项填空练习,总结、归纳和理顺在几年中所学的语言现象。考生在练习时应精神集中,掌握速度,力争每分钟完成两题。

单项填空共设两类题:(一)语音;(二)语法、词汇和习语。

(一) 语音

语音题重点考查元音字母和辅音及其组合的发音,涉及初、高中所学常用及次常用词汇。学生须准确掌握单词的读音、拼音与词义,并重点练习靠音位区别词义的词,词性相近的词,以及同义词和近义词。
