前 言

大学(文理科、理工科)英语教学大纲规定了各级听、说、写、读、译等技能的具体要求,而词汇则是各项技能的基础。

我们经过统计,发现两个大纲的词汇中,除列入了中学所应掌握的1600个词汇外,在1~4级中还有1400个词汇是两个大纲中所共有的。因此,掌握这些共同词汇就显得特别重要。结合多年的教学实践,对存储的大量国内外有关试题以及自编试题进行了分析、筛选,并经复习应考检验,我们编写了这本《大学英语四级词汇模拟测试集》。本书以两个大纲所列的共同词汇为核心,兼及其他非共同词汇,对中学所学的300个词义宽、又较难掌握的词也作了相应的安排,旨在通过大量词汇测试训练,帮助学习者扩大词汇量,加深对词汇的理解,逐步掌握惯用法,增强词汇的活用能力,从而促进各项技能的提高。

本书的主要特点包括:

1. 本书所选的测试词汇覆盖率达大纲所列词汇的80%,

加上其他供选词，则可达90%左右。

2. 本书共有26套题，每套题由100道小题组成，取材广泛，针对性强。编排上由浅入深，便于自学。

3. 书末附有测试词汇“索引”，注明了词汇级别、词性、汉义和出现的题号。读者可根据“索引”进行自我检测，英语教师编选考题或选取教学实例也非常方便。另外，附有试题答案，供读者参考。

本书选用了英籍教师Jocelyn Watson小姐在湖南大学任教期间所编写的大量试题。美籍教师David Bush和Linda W. Thomas对本书的编写给予了很多帮助，编者对此表示衷心感谢。

参加本书编写工作的尚有方瑞芬同志。夏德森同志也参加了部分工作。在最后定稿时，承蒙林汝昌教授对本书进行了审阅，在此一并表示谢意。

由于编者水平有限，书中难免有不妥或错误之处，欢迎读者批评指正。
