前 言

本书是根据“大学英语教学大纲”和“大学英语四级考试大纲”为各院校的调频电台编写的一套课外英语听力训练教材，旨在配合课堂听力教学，帮助学生在课后进行大量语言实践操练，巩固并提高所学的各项技能，以解决课内听力学时不足，统考前大量增加学时的问题。

全书共二册，60个单元，按四级分四个阶段使用。根据循序渐进的原则，各阶段听力训练项目，内容的多少和材料的难易程度都有所不同。语速由慢到快，起点为每分钟100个词，终点为每分钟120个词。

本书是在系统地总结了历年来指导学生参加大学英语四级统考经验基础上编写的。它注重基本功训练，内容包括了大纲所规定的大多数听力微技能及功能意念项目，并编排了多项练习，为巩固提高学生的听、说、写技能提供了系统的素材。本套教材上册每个单元后均有一个小测试，下册有30个模拟考试题，模拟考试在形式及难度上均与目前四级考试同步。书末附有每个练习的答案及录音文字材料，为学生顺利通过四级考试铺平了道路。教材在素材的选择上注重了趣味性强的特点，每个单元的最后一项是文艺节目，其中包括歌曲、诗歌、游戏、谜语、笑话等。本套教材内容丰富，生动活泼，所以除大学生使用外，也便于英语爱好者提高听力能力使用。

本套教材由国家教委大学外语教学指导委员会原成员中国人民解放军外国语学院冯翠华教授担任主审，这就保证了教材的质量。
