内 容 提 要

本书(第二版)是《新英语教程》辅助教材,是根据四级考试调整后的题型,为参加大学英语四级考试的学生而编写的听力理解热身练习。全书包含5个部分。Section A 为 110 个对话。Section B 为 20 篇短文。这两部分为多项选择练习。Section C 为 12 个段落,作逐词听写用。Section D 为 12 篇用作听写填空的短文。此部分为大学英语考试中心 1995 年 7 月公布的新题型。Section E 为 19 篇短文,要求学生听完每篇后笔头回答 3~4个问题。

本书配有 5 盒磁带,即每个 Section 为 1 盒。由外籍教师录音。书后附有全部练习的答案和录音文字材料。

本书适用于大专院校非英语专业学生,以及具有相应水平的英语自 学者。

前 言

本书的前身——《大学英语四级听力练习》自 1988 年出版以来,多次重印,颇受欢迎。清华大学参加大学英语四级考试的多数班级都选用此书,效果良好。

此值套书《新英语教程》修订之际,本书作为《教程》中的辅助材料,在经过多年使用之后,也很有必要在保持优点的基础上进行一次修订。考虑到最近全国四级统考题型将作调整,修改后的练习册不再以"成套听力练习"形式出现。因为以后每次四级考试采用何种题型不固定。本书将按内容组合,分为5个部分:Section A 为110个对话,Section B 为20篇短文。这两部分均为多项选择练习,与原大学英语四级考试中听力理解部分相同。Section C 为12个段落,用作逐词听写练习。Section D 为12篇用作听写填空的短文,要求学生在听录音过程中将所听句子或意群填入空白处。这一部分为全国大学英语四、六级考试委员会1995年7月公布的新题型。Section E 为19篇短文,要求学生听完每篇之后笔头简单回答3~4个问题。后三部分的练习旨在提高学生运用语言的能力。

本书配有五盒磁带,即每个 Section 为一盒。Sections A、B 和 E 按考试要求制作。按规定 Section C 的逐词听写和 Section D 的填空听写要朗读三遍。第一遍为初听,第二遍为听写,第三遍为核对。为了减轻使用者的经济负担,磁带上仅录下第一和第二遍,听第三遍时,可自行将磁带倒回第一遍处。磁带均由外籍教师录音。

书后附有全部练习的答案和录音文字材料,以便准备参加大学英语四级考试的学生在课内外使用。此书对于意欲提高自己听力,检查自己听力理解水平的自学者也不失为一种理想的练习材料。我们衷心希望它能在提高使用者的听力理解水平和

语言表达能力方面发挥作用。
