

前言

博士研究生教育是我国高等教育的最高阶段,是培养高层次专门人才的重要途径。攻读博士学位者,一方面应具备扎实的专业知识和很强的科研能力,另一方面还应具备相当的外语水平。英语是博士生入学考试中的一门重要课程,其成绩在一定程度上直接影响考生能否被录取;在专业成绩相差无几的情况下,英语成绩更是能否被录取的关键。而词汇则可以说是关键之中的关键。

《研究生英语教学大纲》明确规定硕士生词汇量为 5500 单词,而"博士生入学时其英语水平原则上应达到或略高于硕士生的水平"。本书的词汇量略多于大纲中规定的词汇,目的是通过大量的、难度略高于硕士生水平的词汇练习,使参加博士生入学考试的考生得到充分全面的训练,以造成居高临下之势。本书的题型为选择填空题和选择同义词(或近义词)题。

本书以大纲规定的词汇为基础,并适度扩充;注重实践能力的培养,通过大量练习来提高考生的分析、判断、推理、归纳和猜测的能力;根据考试中常考的词汇及常见的命题形式进行有针对性的训练,并对容易混淆的词汇及短语做了必要的辨析;单项训练与综合训练相结合,使练习既有深度又有广度;练习每二十颗为一组并提供答案及简要题解,便于考生自测、计时和自我校正。

本书的编著者多年从事研究生英语教学,在研究生入学考试英语试题命题方面有丰富的经验。

本书在编写过程中,得到清华大学出版社及清华大学外语系的支持和帮助,在此表示衷心的感谢。

由于时间仓促,加之编者水平有限,不当之处在所难免,恳请读者批评指正。

动词(其中包括短语动词)是博士生入学英语考试词汇部分的一个重要测试项目。该项的测试点包括 1 动词的认知和辨别能力; 2. 动词用法的掌握程度, 3. 动词搭配关系的熟练程度。在硕士研究生通过考试需掌握的 5500 个词汇中,约有五分之一是动词。因此能否掌握好这批词汇直接关系到能否通过博士生入学英语考试。本节将着重对这些词汇进行分析和归纳,通过一定量的练习,帮助考生掌握这些词汇。

在动词部分中,考生首先应具备较好的认知能力,即遇见一个动词后,能较快地确定它的词义。在具备认知能力的基础上,考生还需掌握动词的基本用法和基本搭配关系。下面举例说明.
