教你用好这本书

《中学英语阅读能力训练》是系列英语读物,全套共三册分别与初中一至三年级水平相匹配。

本书是遵照中华人民共和国教育部 2000 年 3 月制订的《九年义务教育全日制初级中学英语教学大纲》(试用修订版)的要求编写的。《大纲》要求初中三年级学生毕业时,"除教材外,课外阅读量应不低于 10 万字"。为了满足广大初中学生的要求,我们特地聘请全国著名的英语特级教师孟雁君策划了这套人大都能读懂的浅易英语读物。那些引人入胜的故事、生动有趣的插图、别开生面的设计,令人耳目一新。符合新大纲淡化语法、加强阅读的要求。

孟雁君老师是北京市有特殊贡献的专家,有30年的教学和教研经验,十分了解学生学习英语的规律和困难,一贯主张为学生营造宽松而有刺激的学习语言环境,特别提倡通过大量阅读潜移默化地学习语言。她所主持编写的读物一直是畅销书。她的合作者,本书的主编和作者均为经验丰富的中学高级教师。

本书的编排方法极有特色,前两册把故事分成若干相对独立的段,每段配一情景图,采取一页一段,一段一练,最后归纳的方式,把各项阅读能力分解开来进行训练,综合起来进行提高。使学生在轻松愉快的心情中,不知不觉地培养了阅读兴趣,提高了阅读能力。本书在注重提高阅读能力的同时,还特別为巩固教科书所学过的词语,扩展新的常用语汇设计了专门的练习,也为理解和巩固语法知识而设计了单项强化的训练。以上两项练习均在语篇当中进行,跳出句子的局限,为提高阅读能力服务。本书第三册还选录了北京地区的中考试题。

本书的设计为不同需求的学生提供了较大的选择余地。对阅读感到有困难的学生可以借助插图的帮助,推测本段的大意,并参考右面练习页的"阅读理解题"(1),检测对大意的理解是否正确,然后参考"阅读理解题"(2),对下一段的大意进行预测,这样可以提高理解的正确率,最后通读后面完整的故事,并完成阅读理解题。这种方式可以化解困难,完成阅读,形成能力,对阅读不感到困难的学生可以只参考"阅读理解题"(2),对下一段进行预测,也可以不参考任何辅助理解的练习一直读下去,最后通读后面完整的故事。无论采取哪种方式,都不要在阅读过程中,做词语和语法练习,当全部阅读理解完成以后,再返回来,完成与每段相应的词语和语法练习。

综上所述,本书特点是: 1. 紧跟新大纲, 适合各类教材。2. 各种用途, 不仅帮助初中生完成阅读量, 也可作为小学生的课外读物, 还适合中小学生课外演英语剧。3. 与同类读物的不同点是所选英语读物--律用原文, 没有意改写。并针对学生水平为读物配题。
