新版《企鹅英语词汇+4》共 58 套测试题,适合参加剑桥高级证书考试的学生及广大中级英语水平读者使用。测试内容涉及情绪、情感等领域,以及词组动词、习惯用法、俚语和口头表达等。

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前 言

《企鹅英语词汇》是一套与众不同的词汇学习丛书。它具有独创性，通过测试习题的形式，如填空、图画练习等，以轻松活泼的学习方法帮助读者牢固地掌握所学词汇。

近年来几乎没有人再怀疑英语词汇的重要性，灵活的词汇练习尤其至关重要。《企鹅英语词汇》丛书初版时就满足了这种需求，并且将继续满足这种需要。本丛书从初级到高级共6种。此次再版时每种都增加了10个新的测试，为了便于自学我们增加了完整的练习答案。使用《企鹅英语词汇》的同学会发现学习词汇不但催人奋进，而且乐趣无穷。

《企鹅英语词汇·4》是本丛书的第5本，它适用于中级和中级以上英语水平的学习者使用，尤其适合参加Cambridge Certificate of Advanced English 和 Cambridge Proficiency考试的应试者。本书共58个测试，熟悉本书可掌握约1000个新词。本书测试内容主要为：构词、短语动词和成语，此外，还有同一事物的不同表达、俚语、同义词、反义词、介词短

语、与健康有关的单词、韵词、动词与名词的搭配以及多义词等。

致读者

本书将帮助你学习大量的英语词汇。但是要真正掌握新词，你必须反复练习。下面这种方法有助于你学习新词：

1. 先仔细阅读题目，然后开始测试，用铅笔写出答案。
2. 做完练习后检查答案并改正错误。再看一遍练习题，对你原来不认识的单词或你刚才做错的习题多加留意。
3. 5分钟后再次测试。你可以用遮住已填的单词或请别人提问的方式重复练习，直到你记住所有单词。
4. 擦去答案。
5. 过一天再做一遍。（你应该能记住大部分单词了。）
6. 最后，在接下来的一个月內再做两遍，这样所有单词就印在你的脑海中了。

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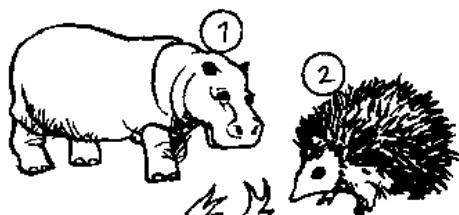
