

本书依据 1999 年最新修订的《大学英语教学大纲》所附词 汇表编写而成。

新大纲对词汇的调整较大:将四级增至 4200 词, 六级增至 5500 词,并增加 1000 词条,作为高级阶段应掌握的六级后词汇。从原四、六级词表中删除了一些派生词和低频词,有些四级词升为六级词,有些四、六级词升为六级后。同形异义词、异形同义词、截短词均不再计数,地名/民族名/语言名大部分转入附表也不再计数。新大纲词表还增加了部分国家/语言/国民/国籍表、常用地名表、常用人名表等三个附录,缩写词、前后缀则由原词表的 12 个和 32 个增加到各 100 余个。

为帮助广大四、六级考生复习应试,首都部分高校四、六级考试资深辅导教师遵照新大纲要求编写了这本《词汇精解》。对每个单词不仅给出词义,而且配以数个例句,并且标出读音、词形变化、及物不及物、可数不可数、比较等级等。本书内容丰富、例句典型、排版紧凑、价格低廉,是全国参加四、六级考试的广大考生学好新大纲规定词汇,提高应试能力必备的参考书。

限于编者水平, 疏漏之处在所难免, 欢迎读者批评指正。
