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前 言

本书特点:

- 1. 严格按照 1999 年最新大纲编写,共收录单词 1500 个,词组 587 条。
- 2. 配有美国专家朗读的录音带,不仅可使听者在 潜移默化中掌握单词的固定用法,而且还可为 其提高听力水平打下坚实的基础。
- 3. 不重复收录已在高中阶段熟知的单词、词组,重点放在四级考试的精品词及所有词组上。每个单词和词组的每一项含义都配有精选例句,并附有中文译句。例句摘选力求做到搭配典型、句式丰富。很多例句来源于历届四级考卷中的原句。

本书使用方法:

1. 读:阅读本书,在领会例句的精彩中学会其典型的表达方式。

- 2. 听:听磁带,从听的角度加强对每个单词的记忆, 必要时听写词汇、例句以便为听力的提高做好 准备工作。
- 3. 说:听磁带时进行跟读以尽快纠正发音。
- 4. 写:背诵典型例句,适时地应用于书面写作中。
- 5. 译:对例句进行中英文互译,以检查自己对词汇的 理解程度,并以此来对照中英文两种语言的异 同,提高自己的翻译水平。

我们相信,通过听、说、读、写、译全方位、多层次的 循环记忆,读者不仅能迅速扩大词汇量,而且还能培养 好的语感,使原来枯燥乏味的单词背诵变得生动有趣。

愿本书能成为每一位英语爱好者的良师益友!
