致 读 者

《金榜题名——高考英语 900》丛书是一套全国适用的高考英语专项训练的口袋书,以习题为主。首批推出的有《语法分册》、《词汇分册》、《听力分册》。此外,为满足上海地区考生的需要,我们还先期推出了《汉译英分册》。

丛书选择英语学习中的基本知识和技能作为切入点。因为基本功扎实了,就能以不变应万变。本书习题均经过精选,特别是语法和词汇两个分册,其中相当一部分题目选自近年高考英语全国卷、有关省市的高考或春季高考英语试卷。习题具有较强的代表性和规范性,覆盖的考点也比较全面。听力考试试验的时间不长,而且听力考试有自己的独特性,所以我们在听力分册中主要选编了一些新的材料。有关内容在成书之前,已用于高三毕业班的复习,效果较好。汉译英分册则紧扣上海教材、教学要求和考试要求,出版时间先于其他三本,实践证明它对汉译英试题的覆盖率是极高的。

丛书篇幅不大,既是精选精编的结果,同时也是考虑到便于学习和携带,能减轻大家的心理负担——这是在高考前看得完、做得完、学得会的书。另外,我们在书中还安排了若干插图,希望给紧张的高三生活带来一点小小的乐趣。

二是要充分利用本书的内容。书中选择的题目, 往往都是典型的句子。做题是一个方面,句子本身也 许还包含了其他值得学习的搭配、惯用法、结构等等, 听力部分有的内容可能也是大家应当掌握的口语表达 方式。处处留心皆学问,希望大家从这套书中能够学 到更多的东西。

三是还要有意识地培养自我管理学习的能力。书中多余的空白之处可供大家做笔记用。笔记可以是复习进度安排,需要特别留心的问题,查字典得到的有关知识,自己的错误分析,等等。学会自我管理学习,进而学会学习,收获可能远远大于做对书上所有的题目,不但以后能更快地适应大学的要求,而且其根本意义在于它使人获得终身学习的能力。

用好的学习方法,举一反三、触类旁通,书可以越读越厚;知识理解透了,能力提高了,书又可以越读越薄。学习没有捷径可走,但学习确实又有方法的高下。相信大家在学习过程中都有自己的体会与独创的经验。如果大家养成一套好的学习习惯,摸索出好的学习方法,并把它贯彻到教科书和其他教辅书的学习中,那么策划者和编者都将感到十分欣慰。

丛书取名"900",一方面是语法、词汇、汉译英分册都精选了900句句子,同时也是900道题目。而按照中国传统对数字的使用和对数字意义的理解,900也可以理解为"大全"。需要说明的是,听力分册有一些特殊性,为保持篇幅的均衡和控制磁带的数量,我们缩


