策划人语

学习外语,培养快速有效的阅读能力是提高外语水平的一个至关重要的环节。为了帮助广大中学生进行科学、系统的阅读训练,掌握一定的阅读技能,提高阅读速度和阅读理解能力,扩大英语知识面,增加对英、美国家文化背景知识的了解,我们参照现行的《中学英语教学大纲》所规定的对于不同年级中学生提高外语阅读能力的要求,按照中考、高中毕业会考、高考有关阅读理解能力测试的题型,结合中学外语教学实际情况的需要,精编了《阅读题王》丛书。

本丛书分《高考英语》和《中考英语》两册。《中考英语》包括幽默、笑话,短篇故事,名人轶事,社会风俗文化,对话、图表、书信、广告以及科普 6 个阅读分类,所收文章 236 篇。

每篇文章都设有阅读检测习题,包括找出文章中心思想,分析文中事件发生的时空顺序,根据已知事实推断作者意图,根据文章上下文理解词义,以及对文章中的人物进行评价等方面的内容。练习形式多样,训练系统有效。本丛书根据近年来中、高考阅读试题的走向,选取课外文章设题训练。试题有较高的难度,具有很高的训练价值和实用价值。

参加本丛书的编写人员多为特级、高级教师,他们亲临教学一线,有着丰富的教学经验,且多年从事笔耕,文章选材科学、严谨。相信通过训练,你的阅读能力有一个大的飞跃!

阅读技法指南

随着我国课堂教学、课程设置、教学评价以及教育整体改革的进一步深化,中考试题无论从形式还是到内容都更加趋向科学化和规范化。英语学科的中考试题不仅重视考察学生所学语言的基础知识——词汇、语法、句型,更加重视考察学生所学语言的运用能力——听力、阅读、写作。通过中考,学生对自己所学语言的实际掌握能够得到一个客观的、全方位的、科学有效的认定和评价。

编写目的:阅读理解的能力是中考的考察重点,也是学生语言实际运用能力中重要而又具体的体现之一。本书的编写为学生集中提供了大量考前强化训练阅读理解能力的仿真试题,使得学生能够在较短的时间内阅读到不同类别的文章,接触到与之相关的各种题型,集中精力提高阅读理解的能力。

本书特点:为了方便学生使用,将所集纳的文章按照其题材分为6个部分。各部分中又按照文章后的试题类型集中排列。本书的文章主要来源于以下两个方面:一是全国各地近几年的中考试题,二是采集了一些比较新的,有代表性的,适合中学生语言水平文章。

使用建议:本书可以作为初三年级学生备考训练中单项强化训练材料,也可以作为初三年级学生日常阅读教学的补充阅读训练材料。

(一)备考阶段作为班级教学单项强化训练使用,教师可以先介绍阅读的基本技巧以及不同类别文章的阅读方法,然后针对所讲授的阅读技巧和方法选用两三篇典型的文章当堂阅读,当堂反馈,当堂讲评,再选择两三篇文章作为当堂巩固使用。每天根据学

生接受能力布置 5 至 10 篇的内容作为课外作业。

(二) 备考阶段考生个人作为补充内容使用, 可以根据自己的语言水平和可利用时间的实际情况做一个整体规划。例如: 每天利用晚上睡觉之前的半小时, 阅读 5 篇文章。定时定量, 持之以恒。50 天以内便可将全书阅读完, 使自己的阅读理解能力得到长足的进步。

(三) 作为初三年级学生日常阅读教学的阅读材料使用。教师平时每次讲授完阅读技巧和方法后, 给学生布置若干篇文章作为课后的作业, 用以复习、巩固、强化对该技能的掌握。

解题建议: 有很多的解题思路、技巧和建议, 但在此我们建议同学们在阅读时尤其应注意以下几点:

(一) 抓住全文的主题句, 以把握全文的主旨大意。主题句一般是首句, 有时是尾句, 极个别的条件下是文中的句子。

(二) 把握各个段落的中心思想。每一段落的主题句通常也是处于上述的三个位置上。

(三) 注意文中的细节, 如: 人物、时间、地点、事件、因果关系、数字等等。

(四) 注意不同类型文章的特点, 如: 故事类多用过去时态, 多用直接引语; 科普类文章多用现在时态和将来时态, 多用被动语态等现象。

(五) 阅读时可根据文章的类型、难易程度以及问题的设置等情况灵活采用不同的阅读方法, 如: 略读、细读、先读文章后读题、先读题后读文章等等。

希望本书能够为同学们和老师们的中考复习备考阶段提供方便, 免去他们四处集纳试题的烦琐劳动, 节省他们的宝贵时间。由于时间仓促, 在编写的过程中难免有所疏忽。在此, 我们诚恳地希望读者提出批评指正。
