## 前 言

本词典包括了《大学英语教学大钢》词汇表里规定的四级所有四千词汇和短语,对一些重点词汇做了详尽的解释并附有例句。另外在编写过程中,针对中国学生在使用词汇中所常犯的错误,本词典突出了词汇的用法,如动词的搭配、名词和形容词的搭配,对一些常用同义词和反义词也进行了比较系统的归纳。同时对中国学生凡是有可能混淆的词,都给以说明。因此,本词典还可做一本实用的大学英语四级写作参考词典。本词典对参加大学英语四级考试的考生是一本必不可少的参考书,是考生备考的良师益友。

为了节省篇幅,便于查找及集中记忆,词条中出现的短语 用法及例句,都一并列到书后的短词附录中。

本词典是集体编写的,参编人员都是从事大学外语教学 多年的教师,因此,每一词条的释义及例句都力求限制在大学 英语四级水平的范围内,既适合学生的程度,又方便学生的使 用。

本词典最后由哈工大外语系主任赵明学审定。 由于编写匆忙,不当之处难免,恳请读者批评指正。

## 体例说明

- 1. 本词排黑正体。拼法相同,读音及词义不同的词分立词条,在本词右角上标以1、2等数码。
- 2. 本词后用国际音标注明发音。
- 3. 不规则动词的变化形式、名词复数的不规则变化形式,均在音标后加以注明。
- 4. 词性用英语缩写形式注出:名词(n.),动词(v.,其中及物动词 vt.,不及物动词 vi.,助动词 v. aux.),代词 (pron.),数词(num.),形容词(a.),副词(ad.),前置 词(prep.),连接词(conj.),感叹词(int.),冠词(art.)。
- 5. 可数名词用(C.),不可数名词用(U.),部分词的反义词均在该词的释义后注明。
- 6. 义项按常用程度排列,并用顺序号标明。
- 7. 绝大多数(除极简单的本词外)本词释义后收入例语、 例句作为例证,例证后附汉语译文。
- 8. 某些词的同义词区分及某些词的用法讲解,都列在该词例句之后。
- 9. 一些词后例有该词的词组及其汉语释义。词组的例句见书后词组表部分。
