

Foreword

A good command of English is an important asset these days for those engaged in Forestry Science and Technology. Achieving a proficiency in English, however, is far from easy, requiring both motivation and suitable methods of study.

A language is always best learnt in a context in which it is relevant and meaningful to the learner. Here is a book which, for the first time (on the basis of China's College English Syllabus), presents 3rd year college students, graduate students and the like with the opportunity of developing their English in the context of their specialist subject, Forestry.

前　　言

一、大学英语教学大纲对专业阅读阶段的规定

专业阅读课是必修课，安排在基础阶段结束后的第五至第七学期进行，每周2学时。总阅读量为250000词左右（按：约合原版专业书300页）。

专业阅读阶段的任务是：指导学生阅读有关专业的英语书刊和文选，使其进一步提高阅读英语科技资料的能力，并能以英语为工具，获取专业所需要的信息。

通过100—120学时的教学，要求达到：

1. 词汇：掌握1000—1200单词以及一定量的习语（不包括中学和基础阶段的词汇量）。
2. 阅读能力：能顺利阅读并正确理解有关专业的书籍和文章。阅读速度达每分钟70词，阅读理解的准确率以70%为合格（按：对70%的提法，外语界尚有争议）。
3. 翻译能力：能借助词典将有关专业的文章译成汉语，理解正确，译文达意，笔译速度达每小时350个英语词。

专业阅读课由专业教师担任教学，外语教研室可视具体情况予以配合和协助。

专业阅读也可采用下列方式：

1. 专业课采用原版教材；
2. 专业课指定英语参考书。

二、本教材取名《科技英语》的缘由

当今世界科技文献多若牛毛，除了期刊、专著外，还有文摘、会议录、论文集、百科年鉴、技术标准、发明专利、广告、说明书、试验报告等。不同类型的文献往往具有不同的表达方式和语言特点。考虑到：

1. 大学生进入三年级，刚刚接触部分专业课，专业英语似不宜超前太多（使用原版教材的专业课例外）；
2. 林业院校各专业之间有着一定的共性和相关性，需要学科渗透，开拓视野；
3. 本教材是为林学、森林保护、水土保持、林业经济、园林、信息管理、以及专门用途（科技）英语等专业的大学生、研究生、函授生和科技人员选编的；
4. 本教材包含10个方面的内容，是专业英语阅读的基础和桥梁。

基于以上情况，故名《科技英语》。

三、选材原则、编排方式与教学设想

1. 选材原则：照顾学科领域，力求题材广泛、内容新颖、语言规范、文意完整，并富有科学性、先进性、知识性和趣味性。
2. 编排方式：第2—6单元选文30篇，约100000英语词。每单元分3组：A组提供生词、注释、常用的词组与句型、练习和参考译文等；B组只提供注释与生词；C组仅有

原文。这样编排，旨在“领一程、送一程、看一程”，帮助学生从游泳中学会游泳。

所列生词主要是5—6级词和大纲词表中未收的词。词汇按段排列，段间空出一行；对难读、异读的词，或注以国际音标，或指出重音与音节。教材中已提出的生词和词组达1500多个。

3. 教学设想：专业阅读课的性质，是由学习性阅读（基础阶段）向应用性阅读过渡。根据大纲要求，教学重点应放在阅读和翻译上。为此，必须有意识地继续培养阅读习惯，训练阅读技巧，加快阅读速度，学会使用工具书，提高翻译水平，以便更好地获取专业信息。

在教学方式上，2—6单元的A组系学习性阅读，仍以教师讲授为主，即“领一程”；B组为过渡阶段，由教师引导，师生共同活动，即“送一程”；C组属应用性阅读，以学生自学为主，教师予以指导，即“看一程”。

本教材若不敷使用，教师可自行增选或利用：

- (1) 林业英语文选(北京林学院主编 1981)；
- (2) 林业科技英语选编(李景韩等 1985)；
- (3) 中华人民共和国森林法(中英对照及注释)(邵玉铮选注 1990)；
- (4) 近期原文专业书刊。

四、致谢

本书在编选过程中，承蒙教务处和外语系热情关注，校图书馆、系资料室、林业进口教材图书中心、高教研究室、中国科学院生态环境研究中心图书馆，以及有关院系领导、教授、学者大力支持，方于1989年6月胶印出《科技英语》试用教材，并被列入我国高等林业院校“八五”教材规划。

在正式出书之前，本人结合教学实践，对试用教材又进行了较大的调整与修订，并请李健、李远征二位老师承担了第五、六单元的注释、词汇、翻译、练习等工作；我外语系主任季健教授在百忙中审阅了书稿；符佳老师编排了词汇表；中华人民共和国农业教育科研项目·外语培训中心的英国专家 Kathryn Jones 女士特为本书作序。对以上单位和个人的帮助，谨表衷心感谢！


