

凡例

- 1.词组均根据中心句(用黑体字排)排列。查阅时,先查中心词,然后在中心词下找所需的词组。例如 suffer from, in stock,可分别在中心词 suffer 和 stock 下找到。
- 中心词按英语字母顺序排列,同一中心词下各词组的先后次序也按字母顺序排例。但各词组在按字母排列时,词组中圆括号或方括号内的词一律不计在内。
- 3.同一中心词下的各词组,如其中心词属于几个不同的词 类或含义不同,均按字母顺序混合排列,不根据词类、意 义分列。
- 4. 动词词组,除必须与 to 连用外,一律不附 to。 例如:stand for 代表,表示(不附 to)

to be exact 精确地说(附 to,用作插入语)

- 5.①词组中方括号[]内的词表示可以代替前面的词。例如: come in [into] sight 即 come in sight = come into sight;又如 on a large [small] scale 即 on a large scale 大规模地,或 on a small scale 小规模地。
 - ②词组中圆括号()内的词表示可以省略的词。例如: time and (time) again 即可作 time and again 也可作 time and time again
- 6. 词组中的─ing 表示在实际使用时, 此处接动名词或现在分词。例如:

worth—ing, 此处—ing 表示在 worth 后面可连用 seeing, considering 之类的词。

- 7. 词组中的(do),表示在实际使用时,为动词原形。例如: have to (do),此处可以是 have to go, have to work 等。
- 8.词组末尾的 to 有时是介词,后接名词宾语,有时是动词不定式的标志,后接原形动词。在前一种情况时,一般不附宾语;在后一种情况时,一般附(do)。例如:look forward to 期待着,展望 be able to (do)能够,会
- 9.词组中 one 或 one's 表示人称代词, sb. 和 sth. 分别是 somebody 和 something 的缩写。
