

本书测试词语共约 5500 条，测试题 1200 余条，主要从 TOEFL, EPT, GRE 及大学英语教材等有关测试词汇中精选出，具有一定的深度和广度，词汇覆盖面超过一万以上，属中高级测试词汇范畴，是测试词汇的精华，可供大学生、研究生和出国生等在参加各种考试时参考。

全书共分四部分：第一部分测试题；第二部分答案及注释；第三部分惯用法测试重点，并附试题及答案；第四部分测试词语汇编，分同义、近义词和短语、选择填空词和短语及反义词等。前面一个词或短语为测试词或短语；后面一个词或短语为答案词或短语，经编选整理，按字母排列，英汉对照，其词义均根据试题选定，词语前面有“*”星号者，表示该词语曾多次出现于试题中，是最常用的测试词语，其中有的有两个以上答案词。例如：amplify—enlarge; expatriate 扩大; 详述。
