本试题集中每套题的后两部分是对写作能力的测试,在评分时需要老师作出正确的评定。写作能力测试题分 READING AND WRITING 和 WRITING,下面分别予以说明:

READING AND WRITING 是在读后根据要求写。在一、二级中要求填一张表、写一封非正式的信等,在三、四级中则要求写一封公文信件或一份报告等,在实际生活中都是有用的。考生从开始就要学会填表,会用一般的生活语言,逐步学会使用正式用语,知道给谁看,用什么样的语气,还要知道如何摘要点。对写的能力的测定,最主要的是看内容是否正确、切题,是否达到目的。考生还应逐步学会用较复杂的语言手段来表达思想。语言是为达到交际目的服务的,在说清问题、事情的前提下,语言上的错误不应占重要地位,切勿以多少拼写错误、时态错误来定成绩。

READING AND WRITING 总分为 10 分。一等 8—10 分,二等 5—7 分,三等在 4 分以下为不及格。举例如下。
