前 言

为了更好地贯彻《大学英语教学大纲》和国家教委最新下发的 1995 年 5 月广州召开的大学英语四、六级考试会议的文件精神,更加卓有成效地提高学生的听力水平,实际语言和测试能力,在国家教委高教司有关部门的大力支持下,由十几所大专院校在总结已试用过几年的听力教材基础上,参照了文件所规定的新题型编写了这套《最新大学英语听力系列教程》。

本教程共分四册,供大学英语 1-4 级使用。每册又分课上,课下两部分,每部分 1、2 册各 16 单元,3、4 册各 15 单元。 每四单元配有一套听力测试题。每单元课上、课下部分分别为一学时,配相应录音带。

这套教程有如下特点:

- 1. 突出基本功训练和实际语言能力的提高。所有材料按 每级的要求,遵照由易到难,循序渐进的原则编排,并加有听 写,形式为填空(词汇、意群、句子)、单句和短文。这既有利于 提高学生语言实际应用,也有助于提高其应试能力。
- 2. 注重科学性和趣味性。每册乃至每单元都依据《大纲》中对每级在语速、字数、词汇等方面的要求精心编写,使学生既按正规训练又可随时发现自己的实际水平与大纲要求的差距,从而相应提高。文中选材不仅包括天文地理、幽默故事、文史知识、科普常识等还穿插有英文歌曲等内容。
- 3. 课上课下配合紧密。课上所学内容需要在课下得到复习巩固,时间分配至少要1:1。本书课下练习密切配合课上

内容,使学生在课下自学听读,在同一难度上复习、巩固并丰 寓所学知识。

- 4. 重点突出,形式多样。围绕着提高听力和语言实际运 用能力这一宗旨,编写了辩音、辩词、听写、单句听力理解,对 话听力理解和短文听力理解等项目,以使学生受到全方位的 训练。
- 5. 便于使用,便于检查。每册编写体例顺序为课上单元, 课下单元,课上答案,课下答案,最终是四套试题答案。

教程的全文由美薪专家邓爱丽(Alice V·Dungey)审阅, 在此深表谢意。

本册录音由美藉专家邓爱丽(Alice V · Dungev)和美藉 播音员 Jaime Alfonso Rodriguez 录制。录音合成刘文敏、刘 文广。
