

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前 言

《大学英语听力教程》是一套由一级至四级循序渐进的听力教材。

根据多年的教学实践,教师们认为学生的听力提高,只靠有限的课内时间进行听力教学是远远不够的。必须课内外相结合。增加听力训练时间及内容,才能取得更好的效果。为了满足课内外听力训练的需要,在黑龙江省教育委员会高等教育处指导下,由黑龙江高等学校外语电教学会组织我省十三所院校的部分教师编写了这套《大学英语听力教程》。

本教程的特点是:

- 一、在内容选择上力求材料新,并选择了部分三、四级统 考的内容,以及在统考中取得优秀成绩的院校进行听力训练 行之有效的一些听力材料也收入本书中。
- 二、根据近年统考中试题特点,尽量使主观题多于客观题,以期更加接近统考试题特点,提高统考中听力测试的应试能力。
- 三、为满足课内外听力训练的需要,在书后附有答案和听力的文字材料,以备查考。

四、听力教材的录音磁带是有机的组成部分,本教程的录

音带均按统考听力测试的速度和要求由外籍专家进行录制。 使文字材料和录音带成为一个整体。以提高听力训练的效果。

本教程每册为一级,共四册,供大学本科和专科生使用, 也可供自学者提高听力使用。
