## 前言

2000年江苏、浙江、吉林、山西、广东等省实行了“3+X”高考模式,向人们展示了综合能力测试的目标和方法,2001年全国将有17个省(市)实行“3+X”高考模式,为了适应广大学生进行综合能力测试、训练的需要,本书编者认真研究了综合能力测试的构造、模式和功能,探索综合测试的命题特点,结合教学实践,吸收国内外有关的研究成果,归纳提炼编写这本题库。本题库与同类学习辅导用书相比较,有如下特点:

1. 本书面向2001年“3+X”高考,以2000年高考“综合能力测试”试题为基本模式,体现了“3+X”高考改革与研究的最新信息,体现了“综合能力测试”对考生的能力要求,按照高考新的要求,在题目的安排上,兼顾了学科内综合和跨学科综合两部分内容,对实行“3+X”模式地区的学生尤其适用,对实行“3+2”模式的学生也有重要的参考价值。

2. 内容新颖、信息量大。本题库题目来源:2000年高考“理科综合”、“文科综合”试卷(江苏卷、浙江卷、吉林卷、山西卷),2000年高考“文理大综合”试卷(广东卷),2000年高校招收保送生综合能力测试(全国卷、上海卷、广东卷),2000年高考“3+X”各科试卷中综合能力测试方面的试题,国内历年来综合测试的优秀试题,国外高校招生试卷中综合测试的优秀试题。试题背景力求结合实际,模拟现实,关注社会热点。阅读本书使学生大开眼界,获得大量新信息。

3. 注重综合能力训练和创新能力培养,试题围绕现实生活中有关理论问题和实际问题立意命题;所涉及到的知识以多样性、复杂性、综合性呈现出来,并能广泛涉及跨学科相关内容,有利于培养和考查学生运用多学科知识分析和解决问题的综合能力;命题注重情景创设,有利于激发学生的情趣,培养学生的创新思维能力,训练题均有较具体的解题指导及答案。

本书是国家级教学科研课题——综合能力测试研究的一个组成部分。本书汇集了编者对综合能力测试的研究成果,他们编写的“综合能力测试题”分别发表于《中学生学习报》、《考试报》、《中学理化报》、《生物学教学》杂志、《中学物理教学参考》杂志、《地理教育》杂志、《中学理科应试》杂志、《物理教学》杂志、《数理化解题研究》、人民大学书刊复印中心等报刊杂志。有许多试题被教育部考试中心收集,并在2000年高考“综合能力测试”试卷上采用。通过本书的训练,能切实培养学生的解决实际问题的能力,培养学生的创新能力。

本题库在编写过程中,得到了上海、北京、广东、浙江、吉林、山西等地专家和老师的的大力支持,在此一并表示感谢。

# 一 语 法

## (一) 考 试 要 求

语法选择是对学生英语基础能力的基本考查,也是多项选择中最常见最广泛的考题。要做好语法选择题,不仅要掌握中学阶段所学的语法规则,而且还要充分理解句子所表达的意思。在考试中,为了正确无误地选择出考题中的正确答案,一定要学会正确分析句子的语法结构和前后之间的相互关系。考生在复习过程中要理解每一个语法规则中的典型例子,对于一些特殊的语法现象要重点记忆。与此同时选择一些有代表性的练习题,边练习,边总结。

如果认真分析十多年来高考选择中的语法考题,我们不难发现,考题几乎覆盖了中学阶段所学的所有语法项目:冠词、代词、名词、形容词与副词、介词和介词短语、动词时态和语态、动词的非谓语形式、情态动词、主从复合句、主谓一致、虚拟语气、倒装句、疑问句、感叹句、强调句等。下面我们从近十年高考涉及语法项目的考题中精选了十题,作一些分析,以帮助考生从中找出一些规律性的东西。

## (二) 典型例题分析

【答案】A (1990 年全国卷)

【分析】

本句的主语是 A library, with five thousand books 修饰 A library,作它的定语,相当于 which has...,因此谓语动词应用单数形式,答案为 A。

【考核点】

(1) 主谓一致 (2) 被动语态

【答案】B (1998 年全国卷)

【分析】

(1) 我们在用形容词的比较级对两者进行比较时,一定要注意比较的对象必须不包括主语本身,如果选 A 则包括主语 Cowie 本身了,因此不妥。

(2) 在对同类事物比较时,为了使主语排除在被比较的对象外,通常在 any 后加 other,再加单数名词,或用 anybody (anything) 再加 else。因此本题 B 为正确答案。

【考核点】

形容词、副词的比较级的正确运用。

【分析】

(1) 从句子的后半部分 he would have telephoned me 可以知道,实际上他没有打电话给我。而 should have arrived 表达的是“本不应该来,但却来了”,needn't have arrived 表达的是“原不必来,而实际来了”。因此选项应排除 B 和 D。

(2) 情态动词 must 和 may 用于推测,一般只使用于肯定句。在否定句和疑问句中表达推测,应用 can。由此选择 C “can't have arrived”(不可能已经到了)为正确答案。

上面两道考题考的实际上是同一个语法项目,即由 which 引导的非限制性定语从句,既可以修饰前面的名词 discovery,也可以修饰整个句子 He was very rude to Customs officer。考题中 I think 和 of course 均为插入语。由此可以很容易地发现考题的正确选项。

【考核点】

非限制性定语从句的正确运用。

【分析】
