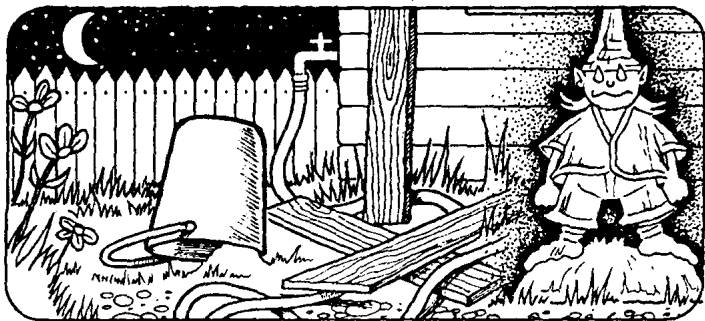
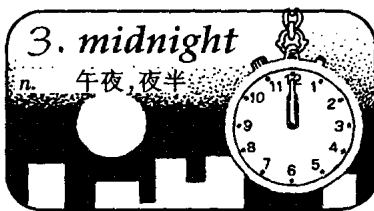
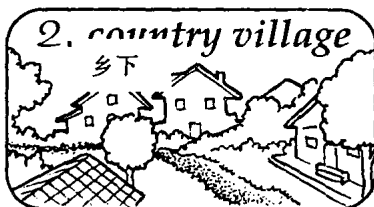
THE GREEN ELF
