### 内容和教法提示

本册以语音教学为中心。在接触了英语语音又掌握了二十六个英文字母,树立了初步的拼读概念的前提下,充分发挥儿童模仿能力强的特点,利用读韵文、唱歌曲等手段,让学生从一开始就学到正确的英语语音,并在集中练习、反复对比中加以强化和巩固,最终达到学会四十八个国际音标,较清楚、准确地发出各音标所代表的音素;在大力培养拼读能力的同时,初步学会最基本的读音/拼写规则。实践证明,通过培养拼读能力来训练发音、音标及拼写三方面的基本功,是行之有效的,这一作法对学生日后依靠自学来扩展知识很有帮助。

全书共十六课,每学期可教授八课。编写中以五个元音字母的重读开音节、闭音节和 1 音节为主线,再辅以其它音素。每课的正文多是集中训练重点元音的小韵文,副课文则是相关的对话,一方面用来巩固和提高开口能力,另一方面在会话的语流中体现自然的语音及语调。

书中的练习以语音和拼读为重点。为了让学生习惯于根据音标读出单词,在每课的练习II中分别列出符合读音/拼写规则的已学过的单词、本册内将出现的单词及今后诸册中会出现的单词。对于练习材料,教师可变换形式加以灵活运用,如练习II可用作听写音标的课堂练习,也可以作为练习拼读的课外书面作业。按照教法要求,学生应具备听写单音节、双音节和包含辅音连级的音标单词的能力。

全书共收单词209个(第一册未要求拼写的仍列为生词),其中要求拼写的有158个,词组30个,英语歌曲13首和短剧2个。书后附有日常问答40句,其中的生词并不要求读写。这些话要天天练,每节课也要抽出五分钟时间来问答或连续叙述,久之,学生便能对学校及家庭生活作比较系统的表述。

方碧辉 1986年10月 读了方碧辉同志编著的《英语》1~4册,深有感触: 这是新中国成立以来,我们自己培养出来的教师,通过多年 教改实践,自己创造的教育方法(不仅是教学方法)和自己 编出的教材。

这些年,国内同类教材也有,但以照搬、移植书籍中现成课文居多,恰似削足适履,以致教师、学生均不能适应。近日还风行国外教材,引进以为己用,但改编不当,读之啼笑皆非。这套《英语》不能说全无这类毛病,但我认为95%的内容、教法,适合于课堂学习,语言是规范的,既不是"时髦"英语,更不是美国土话。对我们中国学生,应当说是信得过,学了得益的英文,可以用一辈子的。

方碧辉老师在课堂上献心力二十年,勤学、多思、善总结,被评为特级教师。我十分喜爱她结合小学生生活编写的亲切有味的教材,并愿把这套《英语》推荐给教育界,供各地学校、广大教师、学生和自学者选择。


