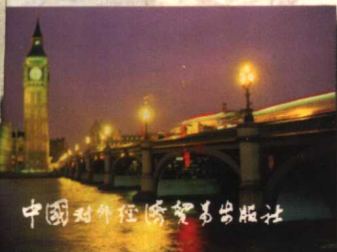

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序

当今会不会英语,是具备不具备 21 世纪人才素质的一项重要标志。

无论是升学、求职、评级、外贸洽谈、学术交流、吸收高科技成果、出境旅游、电脑联网……无处不需要使用英语——全球七大洲的通用语言。

因而莘莘学子在升学、求职和各种岗位进取的竞争中,无不如饥似渴地学习英语,学英语热、学英语狂,这是十分可喜的现象。

那么如何学习、会学、学好英语就成为广大学习者极需要寻找的途径。

为此我们组织长期在英语教学第一线富有教学经验的作者,编写了这套《常胜英语系列丛书》。

中国有句至理名言:知己知彼,百战百胜。

《常胜英语系列丛书》就是把英语难点加以分析,重点加以梳理,从而帮助学者有径可循,有路可走。

英语单词记忆难,众所周知,要提高英语记忆率,就必须讲究方法,《常胜英语单词巧记》通过音、形、义介绍了各种学记单词的方法,分析科学,规律明显,有很强的实际操作性,弥补了以往有关书籍的片面性,是普遍适应广大中学生、大学生、英语爱好者及使用者的英语单词记忆之宝。

英语和汉语一样,为了使表达能力准确、贴切、形象、生动,可以使用同义词、反义词,进行有力地修饰。《常胜英语同义词》和《常胜英语反义词》对此作了大量词语的详实、鲜明地分析。

由于中英两种语言产生的国度不同,背景文化知识不同,中国人学英语时,对一些惯用语作用的场合,人物的身份,常感困惑或造成误解笑话,对此《常胜英语相似词与句》、《常胜英语正误析》犹如两把万能的金钥匙,把众多难点、疑点、点拨清楚,使学者在寻求解答的路程中,颇有“山穷水尽疑无路,柳暗花明又一村”的喜悦之感。再有英语句型尽管千变万化,演绎无穷,但归根划类也无非是有数的几种基本句式的变化或扩展,或省略,再繁再难也能捕捉到她的原型句式,这在《常胜英语句型析》中都有确切的答案。

最后,我们用英语再重复一遍“知己知彼、百战百胜”这句名言,“Know the enemy and know yourself, and you can fight a hundred battles with no danger of defeat.”并用“天才在于勤奋,知识在于积累。”——“Talents come from diligence, and knowledge is gained by accumulation.”作为对广大学子——英语学习路程上的狂热开拓者——的殷切期望。

前言

日常英语中反义词的应用是相当广泛的,如形容体型的高(tall)、矮(short)、胖(fat)、瘦(thin);说明方位的东(east)、西(west)、南(south)、北(north);评比判断的优(good)、劣(bad)、正(right)、误(wrong);表示时序的早(early)、晚(late)、先(first)、后(last);反映情绪的喜(pleased)、怒(angry)、哀(sad)、乐(glad);而运用反义词讲出的句子更是生动活泼,色彩鲜明,富于感染力,如:人固有一死,或重于泰山或轻于鸿毛。Though death befalls all men alike, it may be **weightier** than Mount Taishan or **lighter** than a feather. 她讲话总是由近及远,由浅入深。Her lectures always proceed from the **close** to the **distant** and from the **elementary** to the **profound**. 不要贪小失大。Don't covet a **little** and lose a **lot**.

本手册所选用 400 对反义词,是从中级英语读物和各种测试试题中挑选的,每对词后编有典型例句,这种综合归纳,对激发学习者的兴趣,快速科学记忆单词,提高运用语言的能力,均会起到有力的促进作用。选用的每对词,只就其在某一相同词类进行对照,附有例句,给出译文。至于每个单词的其他含义、用法,均不多加涉及。

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
