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前 言

在国家教委对中小学教材实行"一纲多本"的指示精神下,为了适应北京地区普及九年义务教育的需要,为了适应首都地区政治、经济、文化教育等日益发展的需求,我们决定编写九年义务教育英语教材。这套教材是参照国家教委制订的《九年义务教育全日制初级中学英语教学大纲(试用)》,根据北京市教育局制订的《北京市全日制小学英语教学大纲(试行草案)》而编写的。它分为《小学英语教科书》和《初中英语教科书》两部分,后者与前者在教学目标、教学内容及要求上是自然衔接的,从而保证了英语教学的连续性和稳定性,有利于英语教学质量的提高。

这是一套试图以新的教学观念和新的教学内容来体现新的教学方法及目标的教材。它本着"兼收并蓄、博采众长"和"符合国情"的精神,认真体现现代英语教学理论的新发展,同时又继承了我国传统的行之有效的教学经验。它始终遵循两条规律:英语自身的规律和中国学生学习英语的规律。它不仅注意贯彻语言学的观点,而且以现代教育学、心理学和社会学为指导,充分发挥教材的"教书育人"作用,努力体现教法与学法的统一,知识、技能、智力和能力的统一,全面发展与个性的统一。它在注意思想性、基础性、普及性的同时,还注意了科学性、知识性、趣味性、实用性和灵活性。

《小学英语教科书》是英语学习入门阶段的教材。这套教科书共六册,每个学期一册,供小学四至六年级英语教学使用。

《小学英语教科书》按功能结构法体系编写。这套教科书强调对学生交际能力的培养,强调功能与结构的有机结合,强调语言知识结构必须为语言功能服务。它不仅考虑了语言学习的认知规律,而且考虑了中国学生学习外语的认知结构和思维特点,还考虑了小学生的年龄特征及心理特点。

《小学英语教科书》在内容安排上突出了两条主线:功能结构线和语音语调线。与此同时,兴趣线和智能线贯穿教材的始终。这套教科书十分注重语言实践,侧重听说训练,强调在思维理解的基础上同时进行听、说、读、写四种基本技能的训练。

《小学英语教科书》是一套整体设计的系列配套教材。除教科书外,还有教学指导书、教学录音磁带、教学投影片、教学录像片、教学组合图片、英语抄写本等。这些配套教材相互关联相互补充,又各成系统各有特点,使教材具有一定的弹性和可选性,从而为教师的教学提供了方便,也为学生积极主动地学习提供了有利的条件。




